We had 21 students attending the course throughout.

ARCA

In March, teacher Alcides Marques started the "Conflict Resolution" course, aiming to prepare our students to deal with the various challenges of ministry. We also received a visit from teacher and author Salvador de Souza, coming from the Federal Capital, Brasília. He taught about the history of Christian music in Brazil, giving an overview of the evolution and use of music in the church from the 1930s to the present day. In Salvador's classes, the internal students of EBNESR also had the opportunity to participate and take advantage of this great opportunity.









ARCA

Still in March, students began studying music editing, recording, and mixing in the studio. This course aims to train them to become content producers, so they can contribute with useful and high-quality materials for the Brazilian church.

They are also working hard to organize another National Congress for Song Leaders, which will take place in Belo Horizonte - MG in June.

Both EBNESR and ARCA teachers have used the studio to record video lessons that will accelerate and expand the distribution of training and knowledge.
