

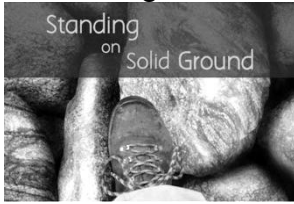
Sunday AM Sermon – May 24, 2026

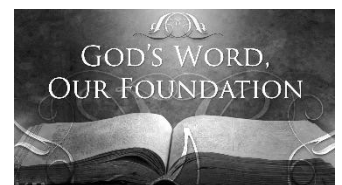
