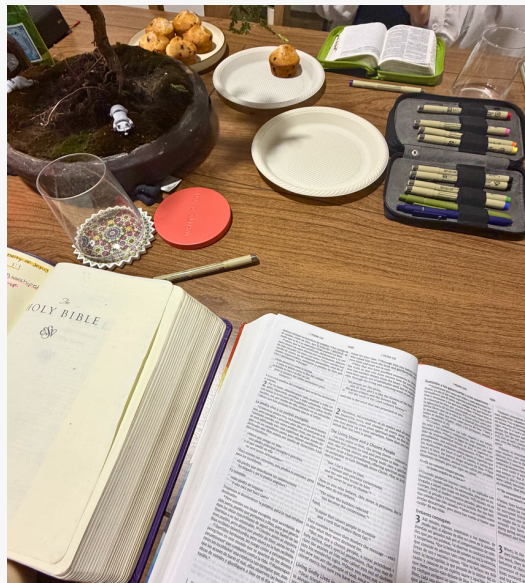

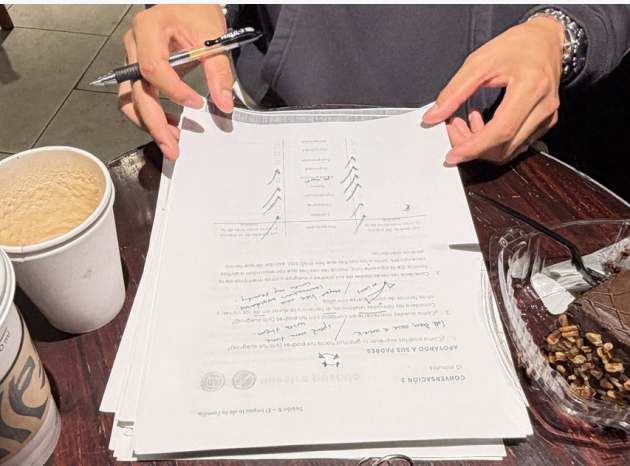


SOCCER
