Covetousness consumption produces:

- Bad Secular Vainglory instead of Orthodoxy
- 2. Commercializes distempers the senses, and poisons the heart and soul
- 3. Bureaucratized Makes giving and helping someone else's job. Depersonalizes love.

Blessed Giving:

- 1. Sacred do it to please God
- 2. Honor give to the worth in someone
- 3. Service give with cooperative directness



Matthew 6:1 - 4

"Beware of practicing your righteousness before men to be noticed by them; otherwise you have no reward with your Father who is in heaven. "When therefore you give alms, do not sound a trumpet before you, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may be honored by men. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full. "But when you give alms, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing that your alms may be in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will repay you.

Last 80 years of giving:

- 1. Exponentially richer, still 2% giving
- Reversal of anonymous to marketed giving


We give proportionately less, but sure want people to think we are awesome.


