(2nd part is a feature, not a bug)

P O I N T 1

Jesus is the complete Christ

By perfectly representing the Father, Jesus is the light revealing God's way, His word of truth, and his means of eternal life

John's clarity:

John 1:1-12

John 12:44-50

John 14:6

A final invitation...

Jesus is making his offer clear one more time.

To see him is to see and have God Himself To believe him is to have the light

In doing the Father's command Jesus left no effective evasion of judgment, but in doing so, has made the way for eternal life. To gain the result, the cost was implicit and unavoidable.

Jesus' clarity:

He is the pure representation of and way to the Father

He is the true light in and through the darkness

He is the word of truth that frees and judges

He is the Life of lasting quality

Is this list random? Complete? Who is this list *FOR*?



The Worldly Mind can't see it.

Jesus hardens the (inflexible) worldly minded person toward judgment, revealing their expedient heart.

The opposition theme



John 12:37 Even after Jesus had done all these miraculous signs in their presence, they still would not believe in him.

Worldliness isn't...

The opposite of mere "faith".

A focus on reality or what can be "proved".

A scientific understanding of the world.

It is not even materialism.

Worldliness is...

A competing faith or religion of idolatry.

It worships self-salvation, expediency, truthless

"practicality" and ruthless "inevitability".

It believes in power and excuses.

P O I N T 3

Worldliness won't believe in plain godliness

After all, at it's core, worldliness is pretentious godlessness

John 12:38

This was to fulfill the word of Isaiah the prophet:


"Lord, who has believed our message and to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed?"
