Discouraged Ambition


Something you can't seem to achieve, but you'd rather be a failure than give up on the ambition.

You'd be more discouraged or ashamed to give up the ideal than actually falling short of it.

Or:

You love the ideal more than success.

Irreligious betrayal



"Love one another as I have loved you."

Faithless betrayal



The New Command:

Love one another as Jesus loved us.

P O I N T 1

Loving one another is the absence law

"When he was gone, Jesus said, 'Now is the Son of Man glorified and God is glorified in him. If God is glorified in him, God will glorify the Son in himself, and will glorify him at once. My children, I will be with you only a little longer. You will look for me, and just as I told the Jews, so I tell you now: Where I am going, you cannot come. A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." John 13:31-34

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Spiritual Family

Examples: John 13:34, 1 John 14-16, Galatians 6:10

Spiritual family has a primacy loving and acts as family has in social relations.

Application:

Loving one another in the spiritual family of disciples like Jesus is the way of discipleship in Jesus' physical absence.

P O I N T 2

Loving one another must be in the character of Jesus

"A new command I give you: Love one another. **As I have loved you**, so you must love one another. **By this** all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." John 13:34-35

Love must be in Jesus' image, not Jesus in love's image.

Jesus came to reveal authentic love; love did not come to reveal the authentic Jesus.

Love

Love is to serve the true good of another in the light of the grace and truth supremely revealed in Jesus the Christ.

Character of Jesus' Love:

Grace and truth
Spirit and truth
Sacrificial humility
The Father's will
Seek first his kingdom and righteousness
Do not love the world
Confrontation and encouragement (not affirmation)

A start. Read the whole Bible...

Counterfeits of Jesus' Love:

Empathy instead of compassion
Affirmation instead of encouragement
Interest without sacrifice
Loving the world, hating your neighbor
High ideals, inconstant excercises
Passionate desire, no time to spare
Objects of gain, not persons of worth

Don't expect the flesh or world to promote "hate" - expect it to <u>redefine</u> love

Loving one another is the public proof of discipleship

"By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." John 13:35

Love as Authentication

Undeniable Love

Deniable Love

Jesus' love has the power of an authenticating proof the we beleive in him.

Traditionalism, politics, moralism, legalism, insularity, self-righteousness, & self-help proves we're like everyone else.

Uncommon love bridges:

Housing people: interns, engaged, single, in need Adoption, fostering, sheltering (safe families) Supporting refugees (Case de Fe) Hosting churches in our building Multiethnic partnerships Financial generosity to unconnected ministries Solidarity with attcked brothers and sisters Walking with somone every week for 2 years Mentoring and discipling younger believers Sharing breastmilk with a mom in need

Common Love Gaps:

Avoiding forgiveness and reconciliation Tolerating harm to those we should protect (vs. hurt) Accepting dividing walls of hostility Avoiding relational stresses Status and hierarchically relational interests Friendly without friendship Seeing people by their worst part (ex. politics) Keeping our money, time, privacy, and children "safe"

Tactic Summary:

Look closer to you.

Listen, they will tell you.

Make a sanctuary.

Do what no one does.
