

Process always takes longer Very likely to want to work with us Facilities report is daunting Great opportunity- need to count the cost







- 1. How does God do His work?
- 2. How do we find The Way to God?

(note: This whole section is keenly about the Father.)

17 references in John 14.

Main Idea

Our Way is to do what Jesus did in his name

(Proceed with faith)



Believe in God's Spiritual Intimacy

Presence of God, union with Christ, indwelling of the Spirit

3 examples:

- 1. Seeing the Father by seeing the Son
- 2. Being with God by the Spirit
- 3. Recieving power from Jesus with the Father

POINT 2

Believe you are here to do God's work

Jesus does the Father's work and will in *his* words. We are doing as he did.

"Don't you believe that I am in the Father, and that the Father is in me? The words I say to you are not just my own. Rather, it is the Father, living in me, who is doing his work. Believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; or at least believe on the evidence of the miracles themselves." John 14:10-11

P O I N T 3

"In his mame" means glorifying obdience

Jesus has told us **what to do** and **what his goal is**. This is what acting "in his name" means.

The name of Jesus is not an Incantation

If you say, "In Jesus name" you are claiming authority through alignment, not autonomous power.

"Do not be quick with your mouth, do not be hasty in your heart to utter anything before God. God is in heaven and you are on earth, so let your words be few." Ecclesiastes 5:2 "And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him."

Matthew 6:7-8

(Luke 18 says to *not give up*. These two can go together.)

"I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father. And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father. You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it." John 14:12-14

"If you love me, you will obey what I command. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counsellor to be with you for ever-- the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you." John 14:15-17
