# SEEKING AND LOVING GOD

14:15-21

### John 14: Seven Promises

- 1. Send you another helper (Holy Spirit) (v. 16, 26)
- 2. I will not leave you as orphans. (v. 18)
- 3. I will come (or come back) to you. (v. 18, 28)
- 4. You will see me. (v. 19)
- 5. Because I live you also will live (v.19).
- 6. Those who love me, my Father and I will love them (v. 21).
- 7. Peace, I leave with you; my peace I give you. (v. 27)

# Fall in Love with Jesus

Love leads to Obedience.

# Love Preceds Obedience

- 1. "If you love (ἀγαπᾶτέ) me, you will keep my commands" (v.15)
- 2. "Whoever keeps my commands is the one who loves ( $\alpha \gamma \alpha \pi \hat{\omega} v$ )." (v.21)
- 3. "Anyone who loves (ἀγαπῷ) me will obey my teaching. My Father will love (ἀγαπήσει) him." (v.23)
- 4. "Anyone who does not love (ἀγαπῶν) me will not obey my teaching." (V. 24)
- 5. "If you loved (ἡγαπᾶτέ) me, you would be glad..." (v.28)
- 6. "I love the Father (ἀγαπῶ τὸν Πατέρα) and do exactly what my Father has commanded me" (v.31).

### Agape= Sacrificial Love

"Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching." My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them. Anyone who does not love me will not obey my teaching."

John 14:23 – 24

# The power of LOVE is greater than the power of *law*

# Jesus tests Peter's Heart (John. 21:15-17)

Jesus: Do you love  $(\alpha \gamma \alpha \pi \hat{\alpha} \varsigma)$  me more than these?".

Peter: Yes, Lord, you know (οἶδας) that I love (φιλῶ) you."


Jesus: Do you love (ἀγαπᾶς) me ?".

Peter: Yes, Lord, you know (οἶδας) that I love (φιλῶ) you."

Jesus: Do you love (φιλεῖς) me?

Peter: Lord, you know (οἶδας) all things; you know (γινώσχεις) that I love (φιλῶ) you."

# The opposite of love is not HATE but APATHY





# Make use of the helper: Holy Spirit

"And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever— the Spirit of truth." John 14:16 – 17
