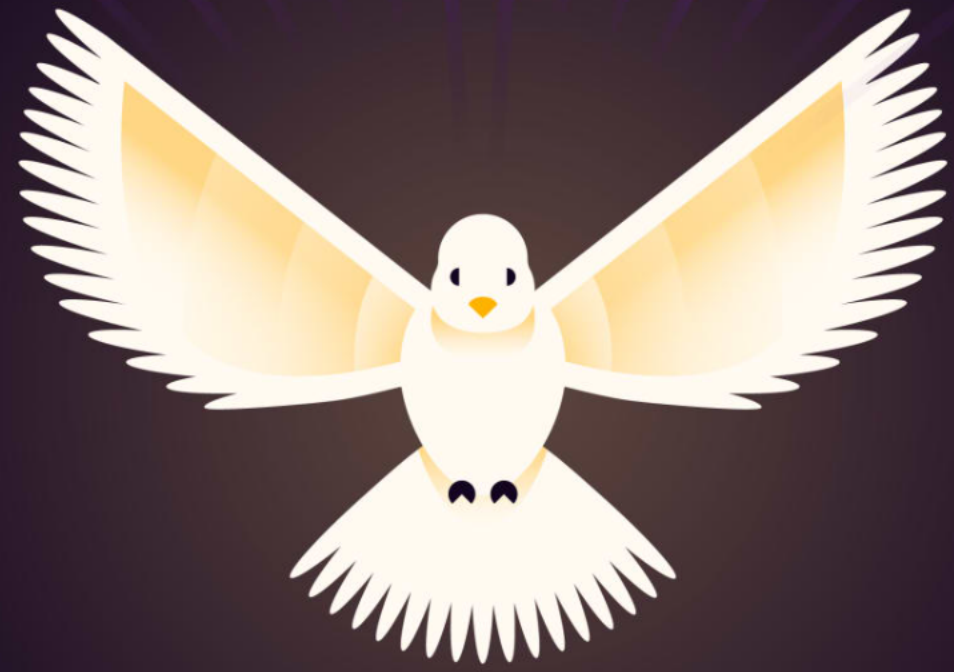


4 TIME PERIODS

- **First** – The physical presence of Jesus; filled with ambiguity
- **Second** – The Resurrection to the Ascension; Confusion to joy, then back to sorrow
- **Third** – The arrival of the Holy Spirit at Pentacost, serving once again as the present relationship, pointing to Jesus as King
- **Fourth** – The coming return of Christ to gather his Church





be true.**





New things this side of the ressurrection

- The mission we are all share




The promises Jesus pointed to fulfilled at Pentecost

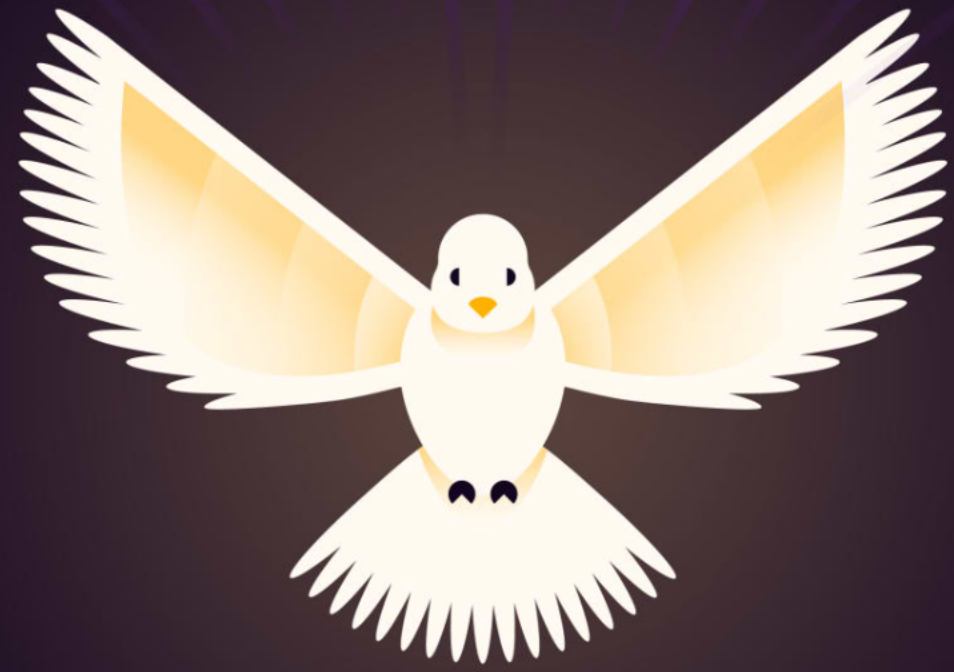
