


## To love as those reborn imperishable

By believing the gospel we are immediately and completely purified of the sin that condemns us to death. (22a)








- We are together adopted into one family (Galatians 4:4-7)

- 22 Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere **love** (phileo) for each other, **love** (agape) one another deeply, from the heart. 23 For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.
