
Who determines our identity?


"The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; the Lord has done this, and it is marvelous in our eyes. The Lord has done it this very day; let us rejoice today and be glad." -Psalm 118:22-24





## This is what Scripture says:

- 1. The Living Stone was set as the foundational cornerstone. vs4-5
- 2. We, the living stones, will be a spiritual house and a holy priesthood who make spiritual sacrifices. vs4-5
- 3. The cornerstone would be laid in Zion. (showing continuity from the beginning) v6
- 4. Jesus, is either the honored cornerstone or a stumbling block to those who refuse him. vs7-8



## The Holy Spirit:

- 1. Makes each person holy and sets them apart from the world, belonging to God.
- 2. Maintains the unity of the temple.
- 3. Assures there is but one *Cornerstone* and one purpose.

The imagery implies that an individual Christian's significance and purpose cannot be realized apart form the community of believers.

V8 - They stumble because they disobey the message, which is also what they were destined for.
