



# The body of Christ is diverse yet unified—in it every Christian is dignfied and plays an essential role


Unity in the body of Christ is possible because the gospel overcomes worldly divisions.



Paul uses the human body to show the importance of diversity within the united body of Christ.






You are essential to the body of Christ even if you feel you are not.
