

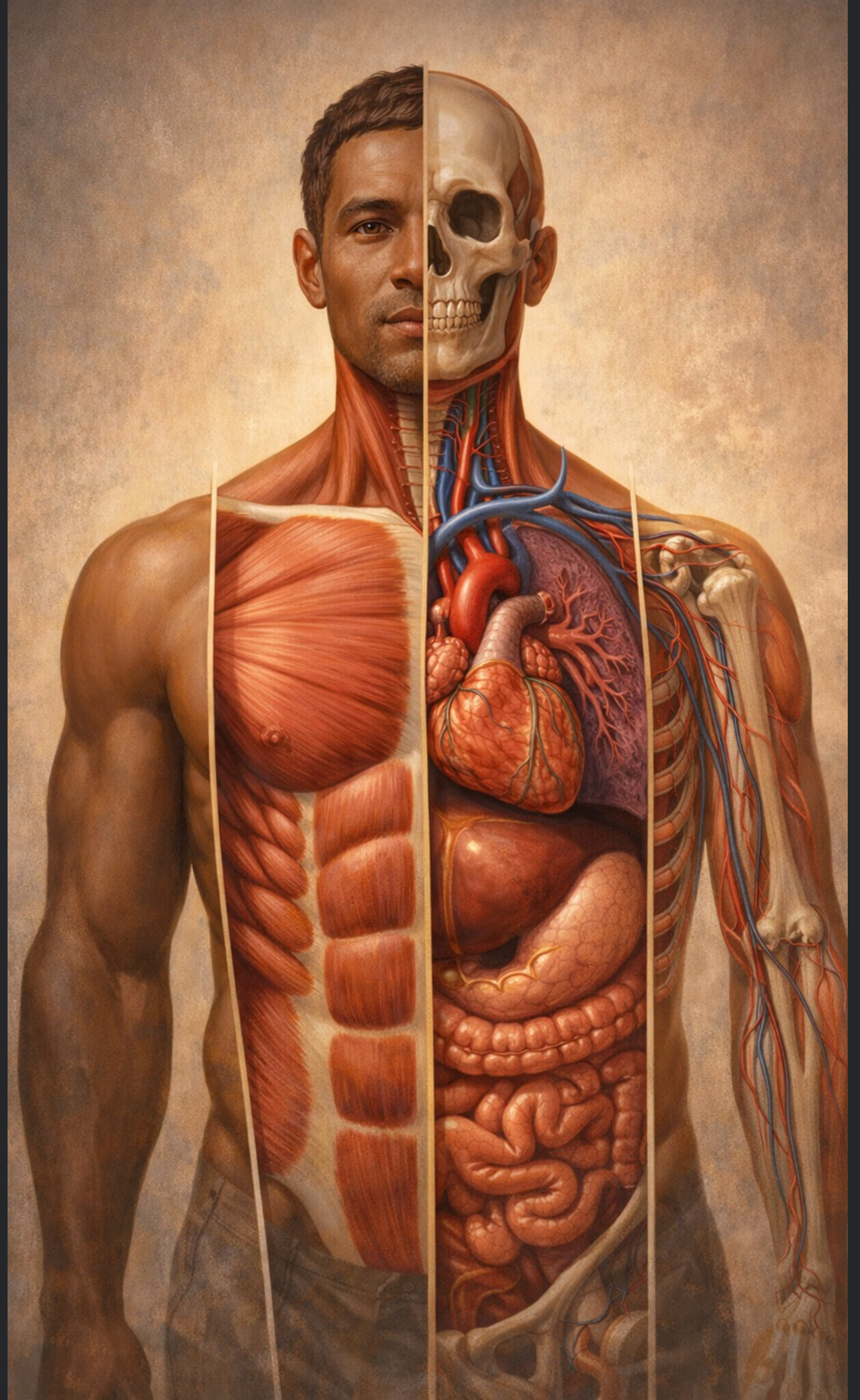


The body of Christ is

and plays an essential role

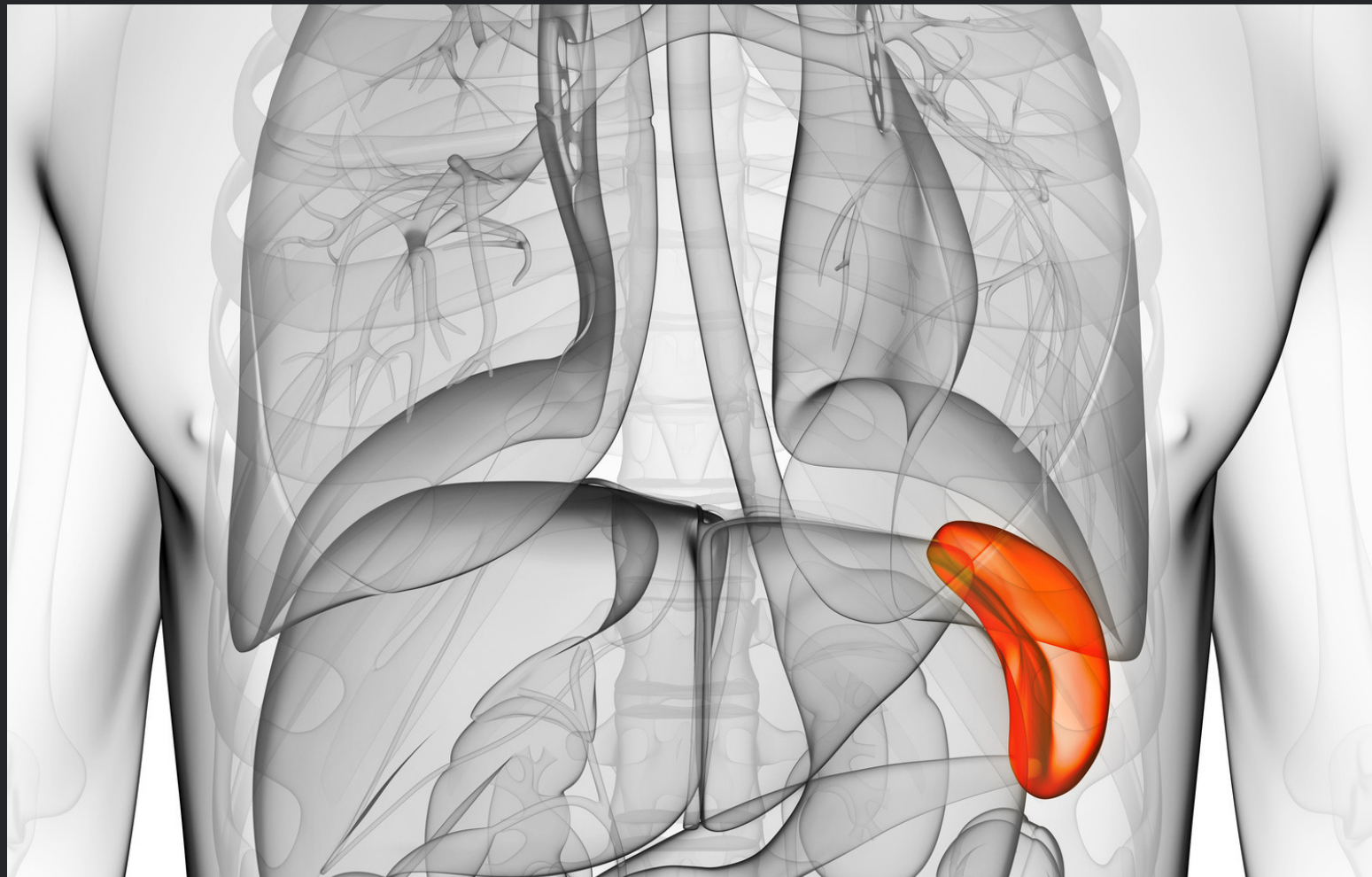
Unity in the

Paul uses the human body to show the importance of diversity within the united body of Christ.

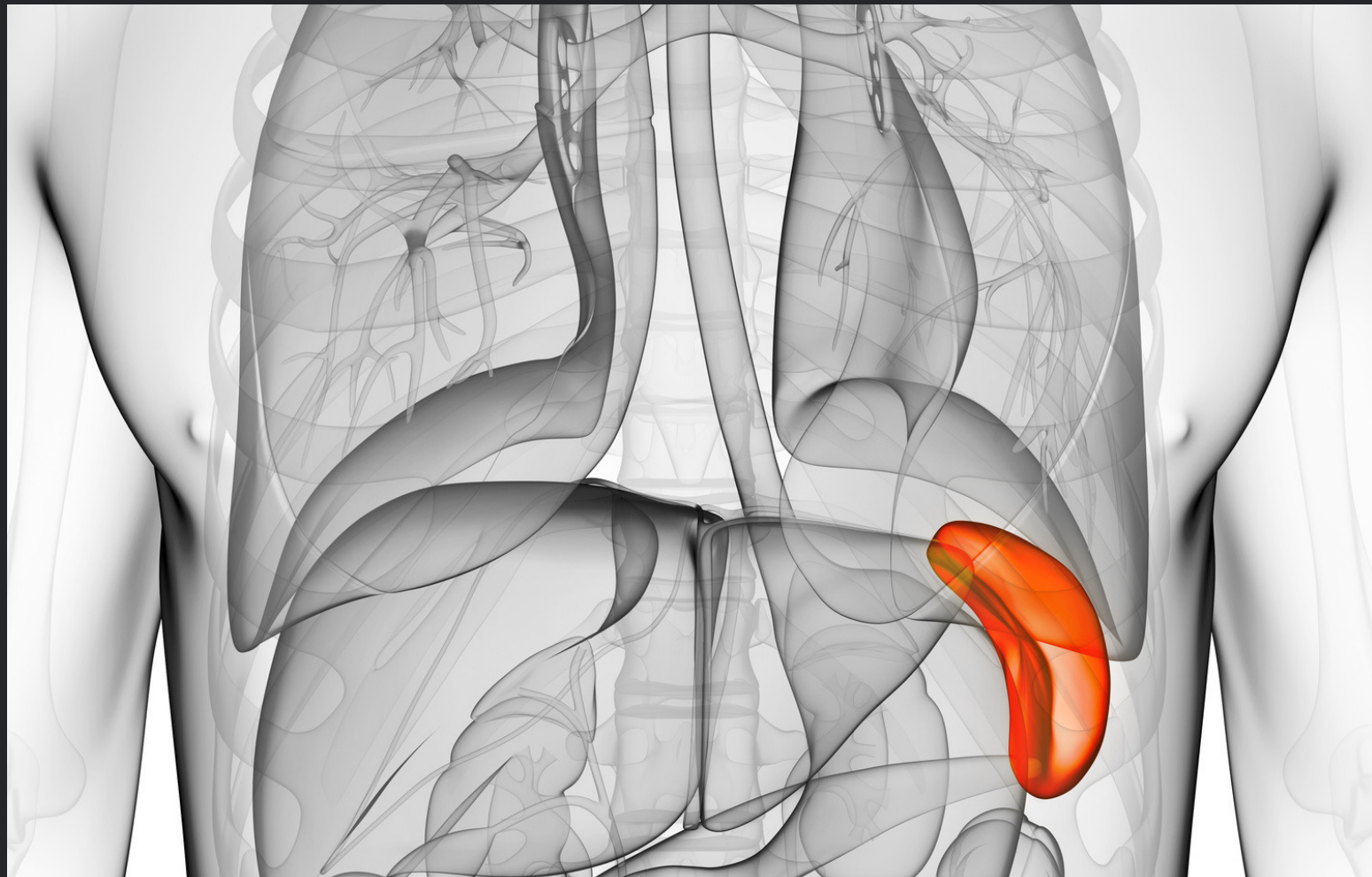


God chooses who participates in the body and Spirit

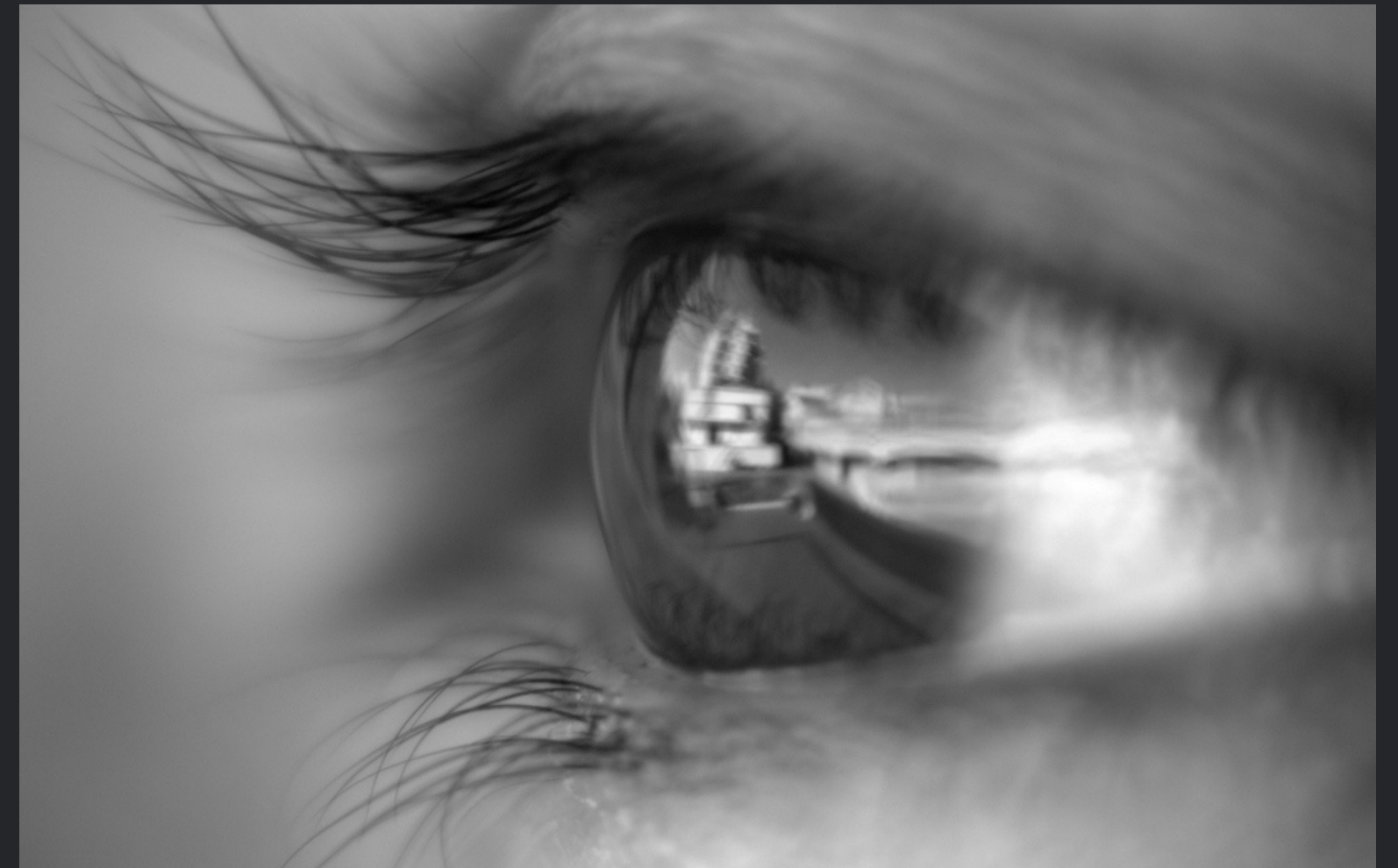


You are essential to





The united body
