The Resurrection is our only foundational help for fear



Fear is enslaving bybeing




- 1. Mortality and death

Freedom and courage flow from the Resurrection

"He might...free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death."

1. Immortality for death

Through the resurrection of one, God proves credible the resurrection of all.

2. Justification for dread

The cross is an atonement, and the resurrection is proof of its verdict. The sons are justified.

"Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies. Who is he that condemns? Christ Jesus, who died-more than that, who was raised to life- is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us." Romans 8:33-34 NIBO

3. Vindication for humiliation

By reversing the World's judgement of one, he judges their judgements on all.

"Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: 'Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree.'" {Deut. 21:23}

4. Vitalized Mystery for confusion

If God's response to suffering was unimaginably good, so is his understanding of it.

"'Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done.' An angel from heaven appeared to him and strengthened him."

Luke 22:42-43



The one not overwhelmed by cascading evil can help you in what's overwhelming.

"For this reason he had to be made like his brothers in every way, in order that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in service to God, and that he might make atonement for the sins of the people.
