our life in Jesus is certainly  
inseparable from  
our forgiveness

this, that our old self was crucified with Him, in order that  
our old nature

our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would  
our flesh...the instrument of our fallen nature

Sin's bondage of  
sin...

no longer be slaves to sin; 7 for he who has died is freed from  
sin.  
when one does  
unwillingly what he is commanded  
- sin rules us

literally "Justified from sin"  
We are free on account  
of our salvation  
or justification
