A Christmas Psalm

Psalm 72

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Psalm 72 reminds us that the child whose birth we celebrate would be the greatest king. And you should submit to this king and follow Him because His reign is upright, unending, and universal.

1. His reign is upright (Psalm 72:1-4, 12-14).
