4. What's the importance of letting the peace of Christ rule our hearts in our fellowship?
5. What does it mean to teach and admonish one another in song? How have you been taught or admonished in our singing at Grace? Is there a particular song that comes to mind?
6. What does it mean to do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus? In what areas of your life do you need to be more thankful so that you submit to Christ in word and deed?

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A New Identity & A New Way of Living Colossians 3:12-17 *Vashon Moore, Elder* *August 4, 2024*

In Colossians 3:12-17, Paul reminds us of our new identity as God's people and consequently gives us five commands to follow.

Our New Identity (3:12) – Chosen, holy, beloved

First Command (3:12, 14) – Put on...

- Compassion
- Kindness
- Humility

- Gentleness

- Patience

- o Bearing with one another

- o Forgiving one another

- Love

Second Command (3:15) – Let the peace of Christ rule your hearts

Third Command (3:15) – Be thankful

Fourth Command (3:16) – Let the word of Christ dwell richly among you

- Teaching and admonishing one another with psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs

Fifth Command (3:17) – Do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus

- Giving thanks
