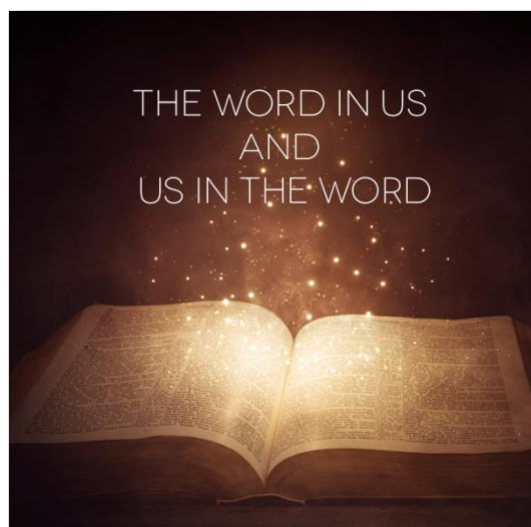

Redemption is the action of being saved from sin, error or evil. It involves 'forgiveness' and the restoration of a relationship with God. It implies that there is a price paid which leads to ultimate freedom not further bondage.

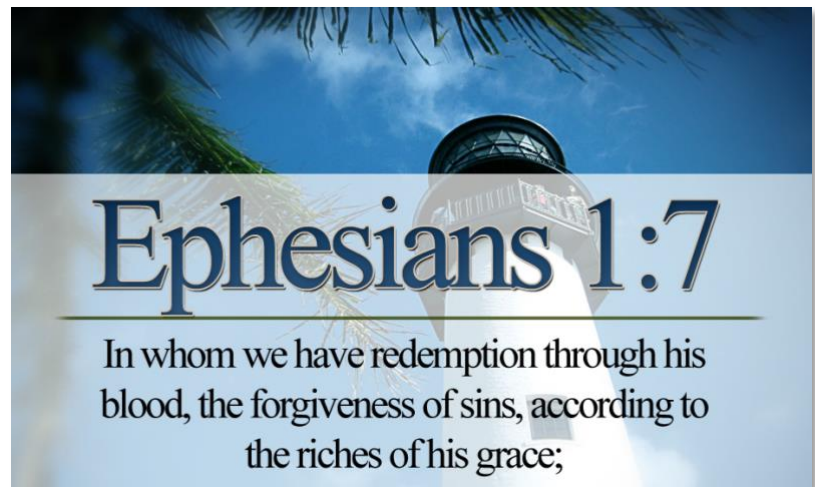

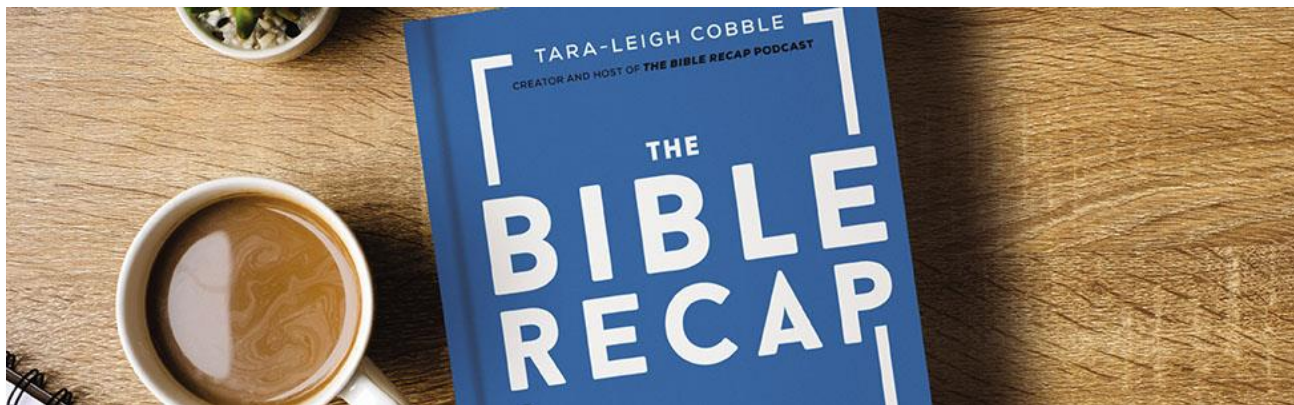
Our deacon ministry loves being able to care, encourage, serve, and pray for our cluster members. Please let your deacon know how they can partner in prayer with you.

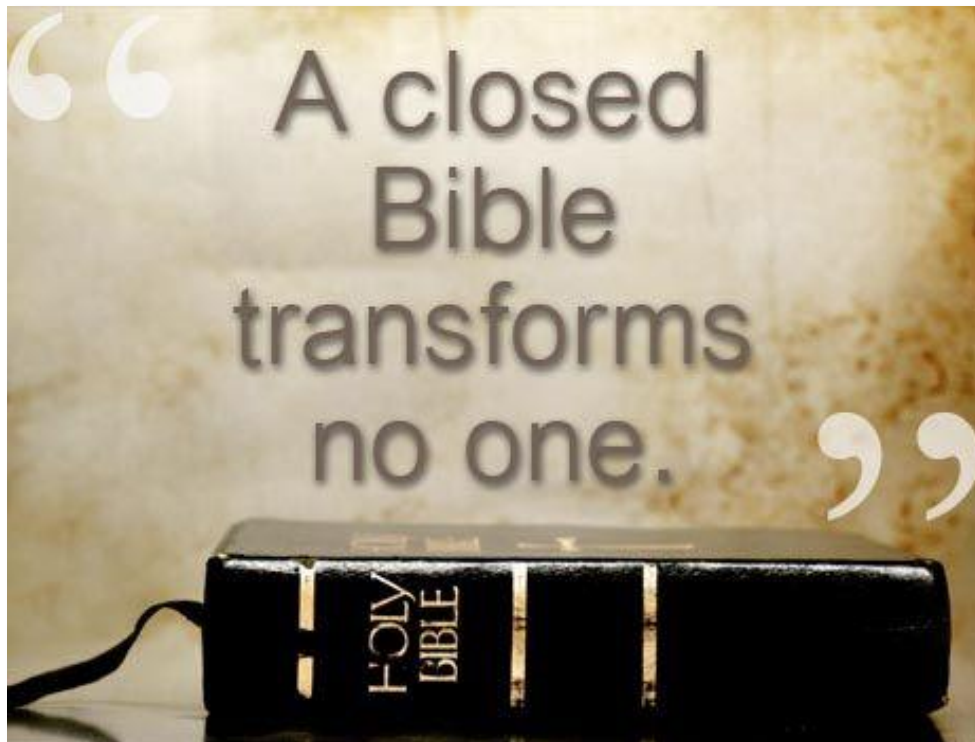
