

The World often targets the faith of believers

Examples of "Sticking to Your Commitment"

There is always an excuse to do less. Less reps. I want to get up late. I want to leave practice early. I don't want to go today. I have a hangnail. There is always a reason why we don't want to meet a certain standard. It takes a person who has an order to them, to not give in to the mediocrity. I take it as a challenge. I take it as a person more than as a player. I don't identify with being a player as the most important thing. It's being a person.

WE NEED TO STICK TO OUR COMMITMENT - AND KEEP THE FAITH

Daniel 6

BACKGROUND

If you remember in chapter 5, the king dies, and a new ruler takes over – Darius is his name

Several key interesting background thoughts.

- 1. Darius is actually more of a title than a name.
- 2. Many scholars believe that this is actually Cyrus, the Persian King who let the Jews return to Jerusalem.
- 3. This destruction of Babylon and the rise of the Persians follows the order of the falling kingdoms described in the dream that Nebuchadnezzar had.

Several key facts in chapter six.

- 1. A new king results in new leaders.
- 2. 120 territorial leaders are appointed, with Darius thinking.
- 3. Daniel is at the top again not just in order of appointment, but importance of appointment.
- 4. Other top leaders are so jealous of Daniel that they start looking for things he has done wrong.
- 5. They trick the king into making a law that Daniel will break, because Daniel is so devoted to practicing and following God.
- 6. These other men lied to the king, deceived the king, and touched his personal vanity and greed.
- 7. They were basically telling Darius he could be a God.
- 8. Daniel is a man of prayer, and prayer to anyone except Darius means the lions den.
- 9. Daniel feared God way more than he feared the lions.
- 10. The king loved Daniel and knew the power of the God Daniel followed.

Faithfulness to God has no AGE limitations

Keep the faith no matter how old you are.

- When Daniel was a <u>TEENAGER</u>
- When Daniel was about <u>FORTY YEARS OLD</u>
- Daniel is now about EIGHTY YEARS OLD
- Hebrews 10:23 "Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful."
- Daniel was faithful throughout his life we see that in each story of Daniel


