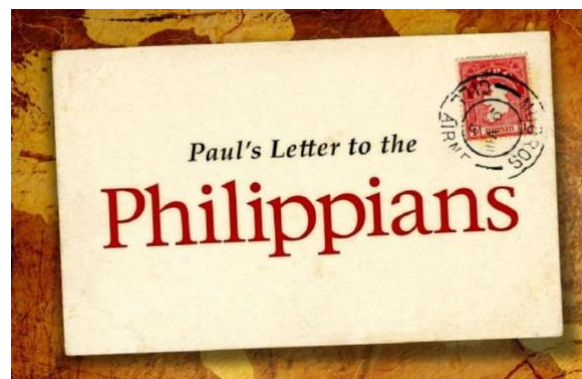

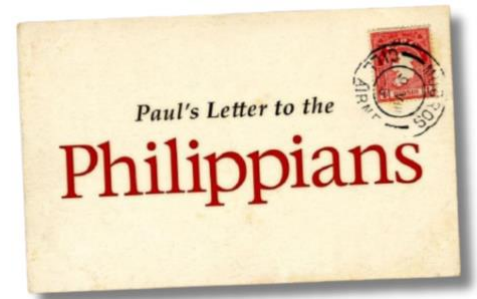

Philippians 2:12-18

Can A Person EARN Their Way To Heaven? v. 12

- The recipients are already in the family of God
- Don't give up on doing this
- A contradiction in teaching

Ephesians 2:8-9

- It speaks truly of being energetic and useful to God because of being saved
- Do the work of being saved – as in making disciples and sharing with the unbelievers

God WORKS in us v.13

This is one of the most incredible concepts – GOD WORKING IN US

- He wants us to be useful
- He wants us to be difference makers

The English word ENERGY comes from the word WORK in verse 13

Dynamo or dynamite –

Examples of God's Dynamo

- Samson
- The Holy Spirit enabled Ezekiel to prophesy
- Rose Lazarus
- Wind and the Fire in Acts

God did not give us an almost Holy Spirit, a sometimes Holy Spirit, not even a Holy Spirit Junior.

Become a SHINING EXAMPLE v.15

Every coach loves someone who leads by example

This verse points to being a shining example

This verse points out how needy this generation is

- Crooked
- Filled with error
- Lacking direction

There is a PROMISE to be BELIEVED v. 16-18

I did not run or labor for nothing

Grumbling, murmuring, complaining, and having disputes can easily be a problem

- It was in the early church
- And it can be today

The real needs of an unbeliever are....

CHARACTER AND INTEGRITY

This passage speaks a great deal to doing the right thing, with the right attitude regardless of whether anyone is watching. This is the story of Character and Integrity.

Character is doing...

- "Character is simply doing the right thing automatically."
- "Character can be trained into children"

Integrity is similar, and integrity has character at its base.

- Integrity is character from the heart.
 - It is doing actions for the right reasons.
 - Integrity is the parent of character.
 - "Integrity has all the heart, and then doing the behavior habitually is character"

When a person has Biblical integrity, there is a desire to correct poor repetition and imitate Biblical principles.

Integrity is the unwavering determination of the heart to do the right thing, no matter what.

Habits and character are what people see - Integrity is who you ARE.

CLOSING
