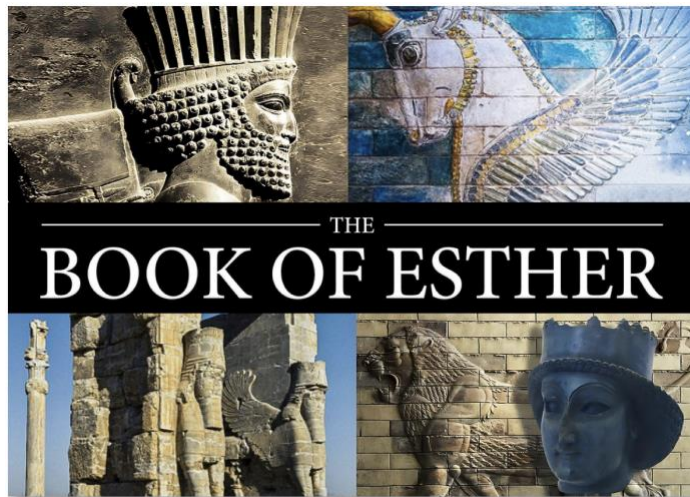

---

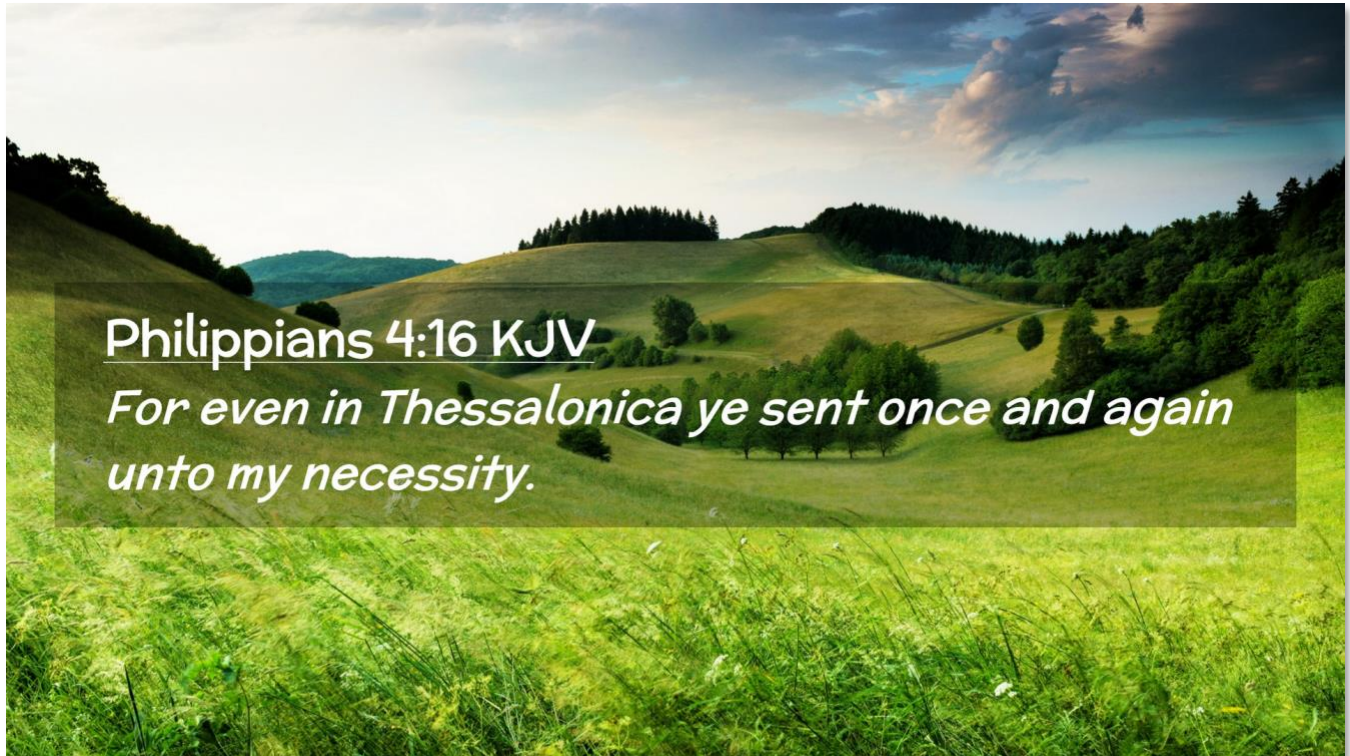

## **Life Together Group**

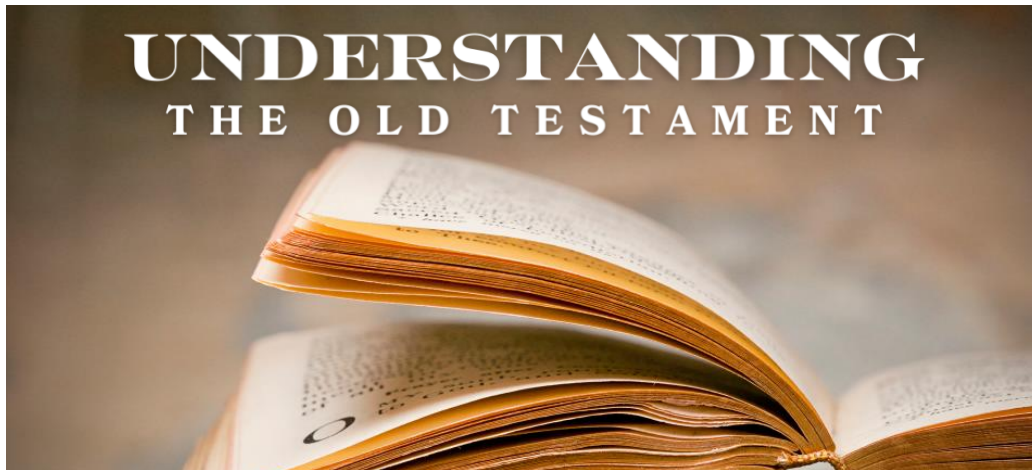
