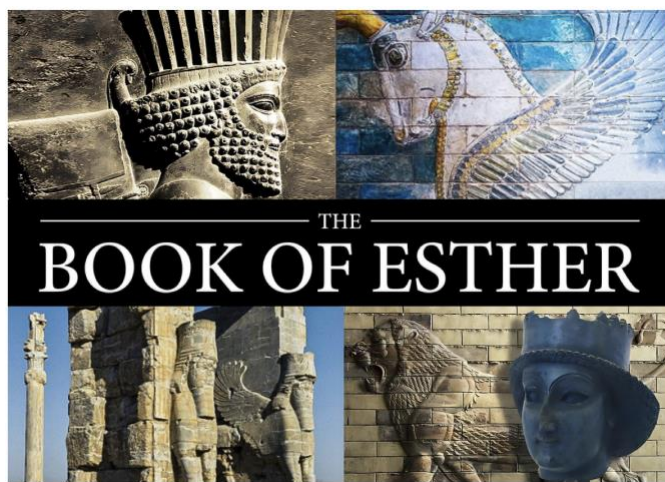

Haman and His Upside-Down World

Esther 6

Being mistreated or even being abused is wrong. Sometimes we know it is taking place and other times we are not aware of plans for such things taking place in the future. Today we capture the life of selfish behavior and the need for being humble - contrasted by the righteousness and the reminder that God is always working and nothing goes unnoticed and is exempt from His justice.

Greed is a destroyer

"What should be done for the man the king delights to honor...who is there that the king would rather honor than me?" v. 6

- Greed – each person's appetite and poison are a little different.
- Greed destroys....
- Greed has three favorite words...

Things are often different than they seem

"Haman said to the king, 'For the man whom the king desires to honor...'" v. 7

- Haman's imagination is tremendous
 - The Irony of verse 10 is incredible

Being humbled is really different from being humble

“Mordecai returned to the King’s gate” v.

- Haman is symbol of pride, arrogance and greed
- Mordecai chose a life of service

More is noticed than we could ever imagine

“It was found recorded there that Mordecai had exposed Bigthana and Teresh...” v. 2

- The story says –
Mordecai will be killed by Haman,....
yet the story isn’t over
- Some rewards are not immediate
