



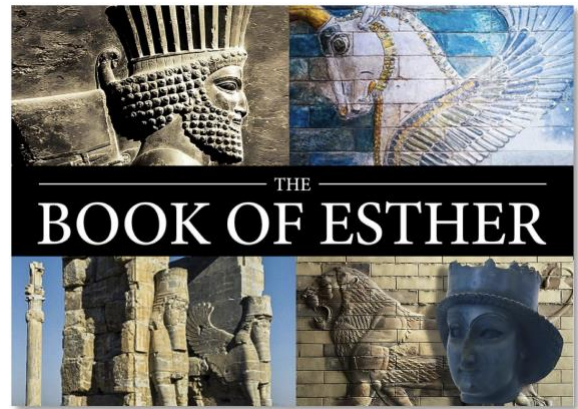

REVIEW

- Persian empire has control of the world, and God's chosen people, the Jews are still living in despair, with a destroyed city temple and walls in shambles.
- A Jewish woman named Esther living in the Persian empire, where the powerful king has dethroned his wife and queen, becomes queen.
- During this time there is an evil and selfish man named Haman who wants all the Jews destroyed and persuades the king sign a plan that in a year - all the Jews will be killed.
- She risks her life two times before the king, as she is committed to serving God and serving people.

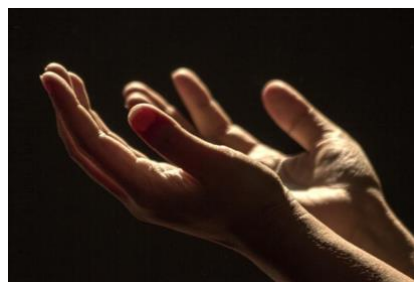
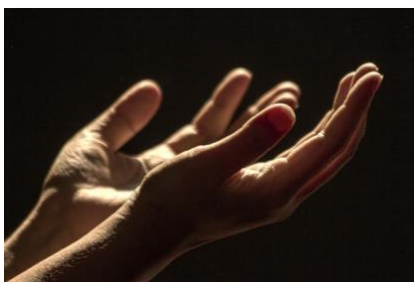
