





REVIEW

- Persian empire has control of the world, and Gods chosen people, the Jews are still living in despair, with a destroyed city temple and walls in shambles.
- A Jewish woman named Esther living in the Persian empire, where the powerful king has dethroned his wife and queen, becomes queen.
