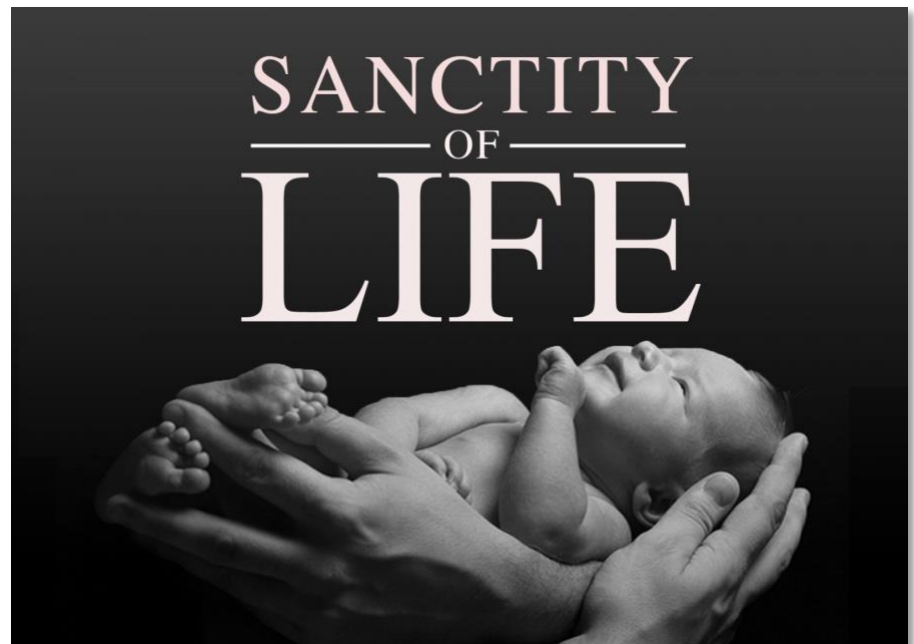

1. Be Grateful

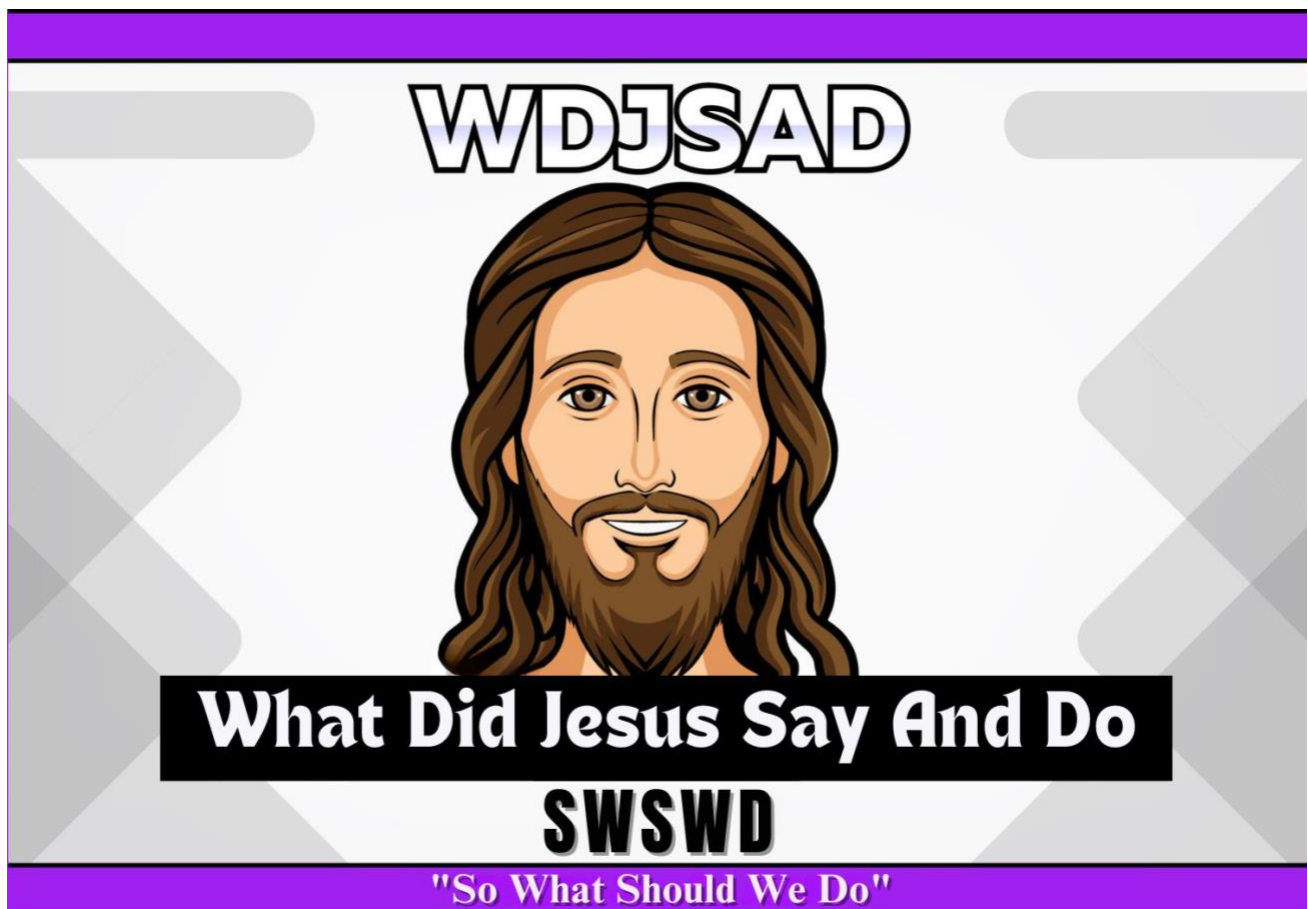
- Pause and thank God regularly

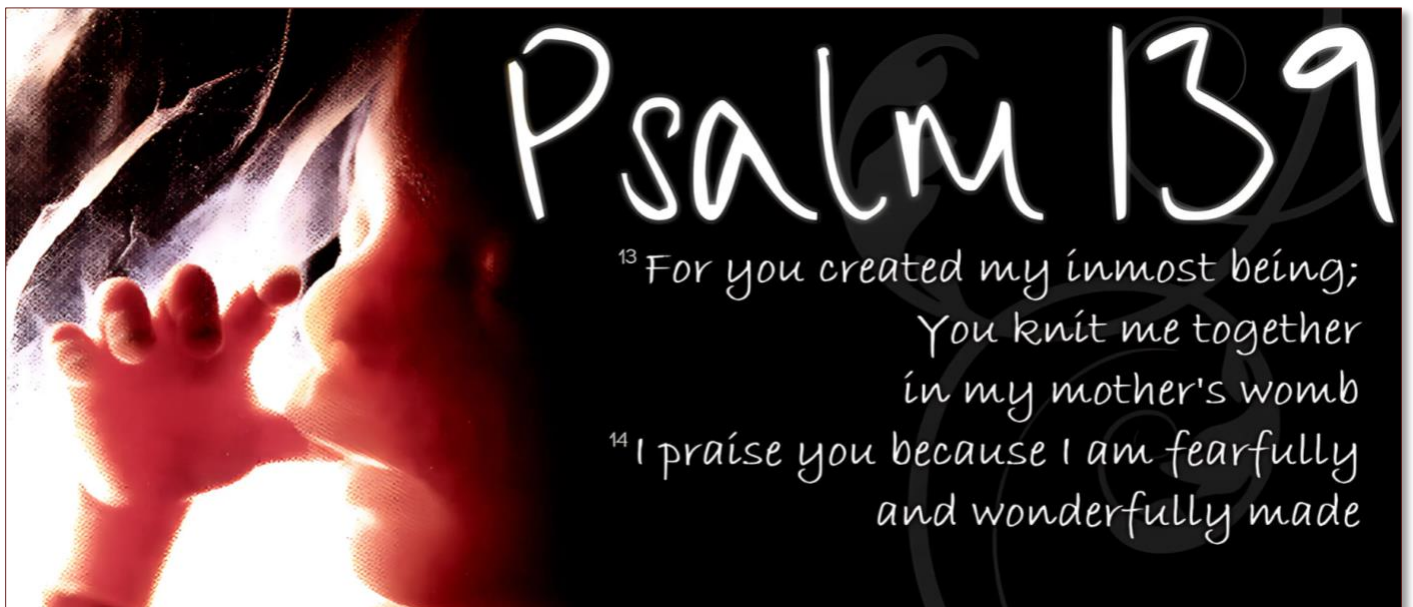
