Requirements:

2. Must be a full-time student of a college or university in Texas in the fall of the year in which award is given
3. Must be in the top half of his/her graduating class or in good academic standing in college
4. Must have an interest in entering the field of education
5. Letter of reference required from a member of high school faculty or school administration
6. Scholarship shall be for one year and is renewable. Preference given to student attempting to renew. Not eligible for more than four years.
7. Photo attached to application

Samaritan School Class Scholarship - \$1,200.00

Requirements:

1. Member of First UMC Arlington
2. Must have definite plans of pursuing an education or trade at an accredited college or trade school
3. Letter of reference required from a member of high school faculty or school administration
4. Must demonstrate high moral character, personal integrity and leadership ability
5. Photo attached to application

* Scholarship is for \$1,200; payable in two installments, \$600 for the Fall and \$600 for the Spring.
