

PHCA promotes Summer Studies in order to keep our student's minds active and ready to return to school on July 26, 2024. Concepts that your child should know and practice are listed below by grade level. Selected concepts will be assigned via Khan Academy and students will be assessed on their mastery and completion of the assignments. Students may also search Khan Academy to review other concepts on their own. The ones that are assigned should be completed by Thursday, August 1st. Quizzes may be attempted unlimited times to help with understanding.

- 2. Click on SIGN UP in the top right hand corner. Enter Code below first. Then click on Create an Account.
- 3. Enter your **Date of Birth**. Continue with Google using your example@phcaschools.org email that will be issued to you.

Your Math Class will appear on the left side of your screen (i.e. 06 MATH PHCA 24/25) and the center will show your summer studies assignments under "My Assignments".

Attempt all assignments and try to score 70% or more. You will be graded on completion of all your assignments. NOTE: PHCA Math is accelerated and one year ahead of public school. PHCA 6th does 6th/7th, PHCA 7th does 8th, PHCA 8th does Algebra 1 (9th Grade for public school)

Unfortunately, it is often tossed aside as old and irrelevant, or simply taken for granted. In addition to the assigned reading, students may use commentaries or other resources to glean better insights, if needed. Use this summer project to gain a deeper appreciation for the gift of God's Word. This paper counts for both a Language Arts and Bible grade for the first quarter and is due **Thursday, August 1**st.

- 1. Make a list of 10 words that are unfamiliar to you as you read through your assigned book.
- 2. Describe in your own words what you think each word means.
- 3. Find and write the real definition for each word from the dictionary.
- 4. Note for each word if your definition was accurate to the real definition?

Bible/Essay:

Choose a character from the book that you either liked or disliked and answer the following questions: Why did God choose to tell his or her story in the Bible? How do you think this character's story adds to the Big story of Scripture.

Write a Character Analysis Essay based on the character you chose. This will be a 5 paragraph essay.

- 1. 1st Paragraph: The **INTRODUCTION**. Capture the reader with a narrative "hook". Give the general theme of the book. Then introduce the character you chose and 3 concise reasons why you think God chose to tell this character's story in the Bible.
- 2. 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Paragraphs: The **BODY**. Write 3 supportive and descriptive paragraphs to support your reasons why God chose to tell the character's story in the Bible.
- 3. 5th Paragraph: The **CONCLUSION**. A conclusion paragraph that sums up why God may have chosen to tell this character's story and how you can apply what you've learned to your life.
