

For Thine is the Kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.







Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions–Jeff and Katie: Jeff and Katie serve with RUF in Tokyo. They are back in the U.S. this summer, starting in July with a conference in Georgia and RUF Training in Colorado. Please pray that the lessons learned and connections made will be used in marvelous ways. Starting this past week, they are visiting family and supporters in California. Later this month, they will be here in Tennessee to visit family and friends, and attend a conference. Pray that the Lord will encourage them as they encourage us with their gospel reports. Pray especially for their financial needs. Their Kairos group in Tokyo has grown to 60 students, with only three professing Christians and more freshmen than seniors. Pray that C and H's senior year will be the year they put their faith in Jesus. Pray also for HG and A as they study the Bible with seeking hearts.

Mission Memphis—Memphis Union Mission: Memphis Union Mission serves the physical, spiritual, and emotional needs of men, women, and families facing homelessness, addiction, and crisis. With six locations, they offer everything from emergency shelter to recovery programs and job training—all with the goal of seeing lives transformed through Christ. Please pray for the board and leadership team as they guide the mission with wisdom and grace.
