## Weekly Prayer Focus

**World Missions—Rob and Tunde:** Rob and Tunde serve in Hungary and are back home after visiting the U.S. earlier this year. They report continued good work in their church, and ministry in their home. Tunde leads several women from her neighborhood studying John's Gospel. They started with three and now encircle her entire dining room table! Their church leadership is growing, and their Biatorbagy church plant has launched. Their own church is developing a discipleship program and hopes to launch a mentor and training program for those gifted in teaching, serving, and leading. Rob reports that his Biblical theology book was published in Hungarian and an English version is in the works! Pray for the Spirit's good work in the women studying John, those who will be trained in their church, those who will study Rob's new book, and those who will hear the good news of Jesus for the first time.

**Mission Memphis—Life Choices:** Life Choices of Memphis is Shelby County's only pregnancy medical clinic. Rooted in Christ, they seek to educate and empower women to choose and cherish life. Along with medical services like pregnancy tests, ultrasounds, and STI testing/treatment, they offer counseling, mentorship for moms and dads, post-abortion healing, adoption services, and community education—all free of charge. Please pray for the staff as they walk with clients through heavy and often painful stories, and for clients to come to know Jesus more deeply.

**2PC Ministry—Campus Services:** Our housekeeping, kitchen, maintenance, and security teams serve faithfully behind the scenes each week to support all our congregational and outreach ministries.
