Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions–Dean and Kyria: Dean and Kyria are headed back to Ethiopia in early September after a summer on home assignment. They are grateful for safety traveling throughout the States and for refreshment during their debriefing event in July. They ask that we join them in praising God for increases in giving and new partners who have joined their support team; they are back to 100 percent support. Please pray for grace and patience as they will soon reunite with their watchman, house-helpers, and neighbors in Ethiopia. Dean will restart work at the SIL Scripture Engagement department, and they will both shift back into good language-learning rhythms. Pray for those efforts as well as for the Sugi church plant they attend and their relationships in community there.

Mission Memphis–RUF Rhodes: RUF at Rhodes reaches students for Christ and equips them to serve the kingdom and the church through large group worship, small group gatherings, social events, and one-on-one discipleship. While sad about Leslie Janikowsky moving on after 14 years of ministry and about saying goodbye to their largest group of graduating seniors, they pray that Leslie and these seniors, as they are launched into new careers, would find Christian community and be a light in the world. Praise God for Emma Gregory, their new intern, who is beginning ministry on campus. Please pray for incoming freshmen—that they would find Christian community and grow in a deeper understanding of the gospel. Pray also that RUF would continue to be one of the communities where students are drawn to Christ.

2PC Ministry–Student Ministries: Pray that our youth ministry would be a place where students come to know Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior, grow in their relationship with Him, and share His love with everyone they encounter. Specifically, pray for our new staff members—Landon Wall, Ian Lazenby, and Phoebe Carter—that they would find community in Memphis, build meaningful relationships with students, and feel warmly welcomed into our church family. Pray also for our fall programs—True North, 3Degrees, High School Life Groups, Middle School Small Groups, and Tuesday Morning Prayer—to be spaces where students invite their friends and grow in their walk with Jesus. Join us in praying for evening worship attendance to double and for students from 30 different schools to be represented in our ministry.
