### Weekly Prayer Focus

**World Missions–Mark and Nathalie:** Mark and Nathalie relocated to Central Asia in 2023 after previously living in the Middle East and being displaced when war broke out. Mark is the country representative for the Joshua Project overseeing research on the people groups located in their specific country. They have recently welcomed their fourth child, who arrived early but, by God’s grace, has remained healthy. They are grateful for the language classes that have equipped them for new ministry opportunities, and they appreciate continued prayers as they learn both the language and the community they now serve. They also give thanks for the new believers who have joined the church and ask for prayer as they pursue ongoing ministry among them. Pray for one person each for Mark and Nathalie to study the Bible with in the local language.

**Mission Memphis–Christ Community Health Services:** Christ Community Health Services is a faith-based, federally qualified health center that provides high-quality healthcare to the underserved in the context of distinctively Christian service. They recognize that Jesus Christ is the true healer and the source of their ability to serve patients and their communities. CCHS’s vision is to reach 1,000 souls through their platform of healthcare services, aiming to serve at least 71,000 unique individuals annually. Pray for the children involved in the Good News Club, which meets weekly to mentor, encourage, and share practical Biblical training. Pray also for sufficient funding to fulfill campus involvement and expansion needs to meet increased Medicaid and uninsured people demands.

**2PC Ministry–Senior Adults Ministry:** It is our privilege to care for and encourage the senior adults of our church family, cherished saints who continue to serve as pillars of faith, wisdom, and prayer. Please pray that our ministry would joyfully connect with and support all our seniors, including the many homebound members of our congregation. 




