

While it is discouraging for their pursuits and progress to be interrupted with this unexpected but hopefully temporary move out of the country, Cierra and her teammates feel confident they made the right decision for their safety. They know the Lord will continue to work in their absence and pray that they can return soon. Please pray for the war to end and for the refugees and people in the Middle East to know Christ, even in these difficult days.

**Domestic Missions–Families Matter:** Families Matter's mission is to strengthen families, change lives, and transform Memphis by intentionally using their educational efforts to support boys, young men, and seasoned men in understanding their Biblical mandate to love, nurture, and financially support their children, whether they are in the mother's life or not.
