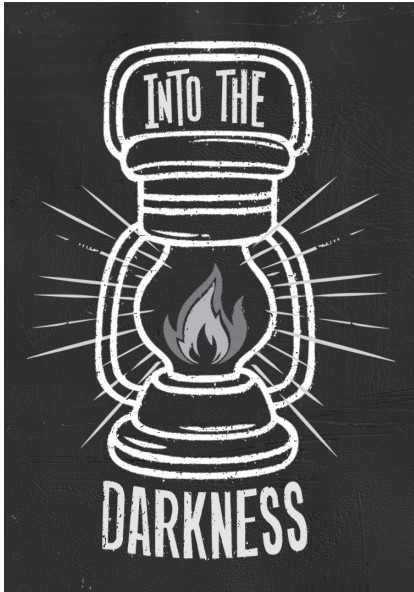
Congregational Meeting: February 8

Weekly Prayer Focus

Praise God for new employment partnerships creating jobs for clients, dedicated literacy teachers strengthening the language center, and a resilient World Relief Memphis team serving faithfully amid ongoing challenges. Pray for clients to find safe, affordable housing; for detained families and individuals to receive comfort, care, and support amid fear and uncertainty; and for protection for the more than 17,600 refugees nationwide—and the 450 refugees in Memphis—who face the risk of detention, separation, and return to persecution.

2PC Ministry–Domestic Outreach: Led by Brian Lewis, Randi Meyer, and Kevesha Snow, Second's Domestic Outreach ministry works with local ministry partners (Mission Memphis) as well as partners across the United States (MissionUSA) to bring shalom into communities. May we be steadfast in our relationships in our partner communities and continue to serve humbly in our outreach efforts. Above all, pray that the hope of the gospel will transform lives in the communities we serve.
