

Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions—Anna Joy and Nate Rogers: Pray for Second's own Nate and Anna Joy Rogers as they prepare to leave Memphis to serve as missionary doctors in Cambodia. While both brew up on the mission field, their four biological children, Maisha (10), Sylvia (8), Steffen (5), and Selah Joy (1), have been raised in Memphis. Ask Jesus to connect them with the ones He has chosen to pray for them and join their support team so they can launch by mid April. Pray for each of them as they say their goodbyes to family and friends. Ask the Father to go before them in each detail of their lives in Cambodia, making them effective witnesses for the Lord in their medical ministry. Pray that many would be healed, and that each would know the Savior.

Mission Memphis—South Side Wildcats: South Side Wildcats is a Christ-centered, family-focused organization dedicated to developing student-athletes academically, athletically, and spiritually. Through mentoring, discipleship, and athletics, they build life skills, character, and confidence, empowering youth to pursue excellence at school, home, and on the field. Please pray for the student-athletes to grow through this organization. Pray also for the volunteers and leaders who serve as mentors, coaches, and role models to be guided by wisdom, love, and grace.
