



Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions—Graham and Emily: Graham and Emily are preparing to minister to college students in East Asia. While in the U.S. they are connecting with college students at the local university and building relationships over dinner and one-on-one meetings, giving them opportunities to share the Gospel. They also are involved in serving their church and speaking at conferences. They are looking forward to attending their agency's pre-field conference this month. Pray for favor with the paperwork process and for their visas to be approved. Pray also for the family to finish well as they begin the transition process to a new country and culture. Finally, pray for new relationships and partnerships, homeschooling their children, and that the focus of their family would be Christ.

Domestic Missions–Memphis Christian Pastors Network: The Memphis Christian Pastors Network (MCPN) is a fellowship of ethnically and denominationally diverse church pastors who seek to faithfully proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ and practice the second greatest commandment (Matthew 22:36-39). MCPN exists to bridge the trust gap between Memphis pastors so that they can work together more strategically to do justice and seek equity in the name of Christ on behalf of Memphians across the city. Pray for unity within the network that would enable them to lead city-wide efforts that powerfully enact God's shalom in our city.
