### Weekly Prayer Focus

**World Missions–Valya**: Long-time ministry partner and now mission partner, Valya has served the youth and orphans in the Rivne region of Ukraine for over 20 years. Valya and her team minister through Christian summer and winter camps, teaching Christian ethics, and arranging for much-needed medical and dental appointments. Pray for the two student camps, July 1-7 and 8-14, in the Carpathian Mountains. The campers are from orphanages, trade schools, and war zones. Pray they will be able to enjoy the beauty of God's creation and learn of His love. Please also pray that each would come to know Jesus as Savior and Lord. Finally, pray for peace in the region where Valya serves.

**Mission Memphis–RedZoneMinistries:** RedZone Ministries is an evangelical, community-based outreach ministry in Orange Mound whose mission is to holistically serve urban youth ages 9–18 as they make critical, life-shaping decisions. Their vision is to be part of God's strategy to transform the community from a battleground to a playground by meeting practical needs through spiritual, educational, economic, and leadership development. Please pray for the resources needed to sustain and grow RedZone's ministry. Pray for the staff—both paid and volunteer—as they faithfully serve the Lord by engaging young people in Orange Mound. Ask God to grant creativity and wisdom as they seek to incarnate the gospel through their programs. Finally, pray that the Lord would bring many from the community to sign up for Rejoice Music Arts Camp in July, and that it would be a joyful and fruitful time.

**2PC Ministry–Grief Support:** GriefShare is one of the outreach ministries of our Senior Care and Bereavement Office. This 11-week program offers biblical help, encouragement, and hope to those recovering from the death of a loved one. A new GriefShare workshop begins in August and is especially helpful for those who have experienced the loss of a family member or friend within the past 12 to 24 months. Together, participants explore strategies for coping with issues like anger, loneliness, and complicated grief. Please pray for those who are grieving to find comfort and healing through this ministry. Pray for participants to experience the hope of Christ and for leaders to offer wisdom, compassion, and sensitivity as they walk with others through grief.
