



Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions—Maria and Michael D: Michael and Maria serve in South Asia by coaching national church planters and sharing the Gospel, particularly among Muslim communities. Please pray for diligence, wisdom, and effectiveness as they lead evangelism and church planting efforts. Pray that the Lord would bless Michael and his team as they equip indigenous leaders to proclaim Christ faithfully. Ask God to use relief efforts following a devastating typhoon to advance His Kingdom. Pray that many would be drawn to the village libraries they have established, leading to meaningful relationships and opportunities to share the Gospel. Finally, pray that those who have recently come to faith in Christ would be disciplined to spiritual maturity and bear much fruit for His glory.

Mission Memphis—Christian Medical and Dental Association: Christian Medical and Dental Association (CMDA) is a local branch of a national ministry that equips Christian students in medicine, dentistry, and healthcare to share Christ and live out their faith in daily practice. Please pray for students at UTHSC to be equipped as lifelong disciple makers who use their skills for God's Kingdom. Pray also for healthcare professionals to be encouraged and mobilized to serve Christ locally and globally. 2PC Ministry—GriefShare: GriefShare is a ministry of Second that offers biblical hope and support to those grieving the loss of a loved one. Next month, GriefShare will be offered during MidWeek on Wednesday evenings beginning August 26 and, for the first time, in a daytime session at The Village at Germantown. More than half of GriefShare participants typically come from outside our church congregation, providing many opportunities to share the hope of the Gospel. Please pray for both participants and facilitators, asking God to bring comfort, healing, and lasting hope through this ministry.
