







Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions–John M: Pray for John M. as he continues the work of church planting through the sea cucumber business in SE Asia. Praise God for good harvests and strong sale prices and for showing them favor with the provisional government, which is now investing in the business. Ask the Lord to grow the business and expand their influence within the predominantly Muslim population. Pray for the current church planters to grow in boldness and sensitivity as they share the Gospel with their business partners. Finally, pray for comfort for John, who recently lost both parents, and for his wife Carlene, who lost her father.

Mission Memphis–Economic Opportunities (EcOp): EcOp's Shepherds Work program connects justice-involved adults with meaningful employment, reducing recidivism and promoting economic mobility, self-sufficiency, and living-wage income. It helps participants develop decision-making skills, build goal-oriented habits, and work toward family restoration and social justice in their communities. Pray for the establishment and continued success of a sales team. Also, pray for ongoing donations, grant funding, and the recruitment of additional courageous partners to further their mission. Lastly, pray for EcOp to remain a beacon of hope for the population they serve in the greater Memphis area.

2PC Ministry–Launch Program: Coordinated by Brett Wynne, the Launch Program aims to train and send out new Christian workers (from pastors to counselors) for ministry. Residents take graduate-level courses while receiving hands-on experience for up to five years in all aspects of ministry work relevant to their particular calling. They are then "launched" into their area of ministry—whether at Second or a different congregation or context. Thank the Lord for Jess Uke, who has just completed her master's in counseling and has transitioned to part-time work. Pray that the Lord would give our residents grace as they balance their seminary classes with full-time ministry at our church. Additionally, pray that the Lord would send more residents to join us!
