Moore (1905-1989), a graduate of Fisk and Columbia Universities, was a prolific composer whose works spanned organ, piano, voice, flute, and chamber ensemble. She is best known for her striking choral compositions. Roberta Bitgood (1908-2007), an organist and composer from New London, Connecticut, served as President of the National American Guild of Organists, where she championed support for churches with small music programs. 





Weekly Prayer Focus
