



Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions–Meghan: Meghan heard the Word and believed on Jesus for her salvation through campus ministry. She is now drawn to share the Gospel with college students. After working at Rhodes College with Campus Outreach for five years, she moved in 2023 to join the staff in Birmingham, England. There she is using her administrative gift as the assistant to the Regional Director. Meghan enjoys ministering to the students through evangelism, mentoring, and discipling. Praise God for the new believers! Pray that they may grow in walking with and trusting in the Lord. Please pray that the Holy Spirit would extend His work through believing students to their home countries and families. Finally, pray that Meghan would continue to abide fully in Him.

Mission Memphis—Advance Memphis: The mission of Advance Memphis is to empower adults in South Memphis to break the cycles of unemployment, establish economic stability, reconcile relationships, and restore dignity through knowledge, resources, and skills by the power of Jesus Christ. Through the Work Life program, a matched-savings program, classes in financial literacy, and an addiction recovery class, Advance Memphis further moves students toward economic stability. Pray for neighbors facing substance use and mental health challenges and for staff as they provide counseling and recovery support. Pray also for Advance's warehouse operation as they provide hands-on training and employment to graduates. Finally, pray that God would give their staff and volunteers wisdom and faithfulness as they walk alongside participants.

2PC Ministry–Recreation: The mission of our Sports and Recreation Ministry is to glorify God and build His church by using sports, fitness, and recreation to foster fellowship, evangelism, and service to the city. Praise God for the kids and adults in the sports program who have come to know Christ over the past year, and pray that God would establish them in the faith and use them to share that hope with others. Pray also for our church members to have courage and natural opportunities to build friendships with families they meet through their kids' teams. Finally, pray that God would be glorified through this ministry and continue drawing people into deeper community with Him and with one another.
