Christ Over All A study in Colossians

Shadow and Substance Colossians 2:16-23 July 7, 2024

Therefore let no one pass judgment on you in questions of food and drink, or with regard to a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath. These are a shadow of the things to come, but the substance belongs to Christ.

- Colossians 2:16-17

I. DEATH BY DEGREES

- People may judge us falsely if they so choose. We do not have to allow it to stick. Legalistic righteousness is specious. Judaism was a shadow, Jesus is the substance (Vss. 16-17; 1 Cor. 6:13; Heb. 8:1-7, 10:1-4).
- We need not be intimidated or coerced by those who claim superiority over us in regard to their spiritual prowess (Vs. 18; Gal. 2:4 -6; Phil. 3:2-3).
- It is possible to begin the walk of faith but not finish it. We can be disqualified by chasing after shadows (1 Cor. 9:27; Gal. 1:6-9).
- Paul is not discounting certain conditions which might impose a voluntary limitation on our Christian liberty (Rom. 14:1-23; 1 Cor. 8:1 ff., 10:23-24 ff.).

II. IF THEN...WHY?

- Paul asks a legitimate question: If you died with Christ to the law and its regulations now mediated by unholy angelic powers and puffed up men, why do you continue to submit to it? (Gal. 3:10, 5:1-12).
- We do not enhance our faith by a list of "do's and do not's".
 Asceticism will not save you, not from God or yourself (Vs. 23).
- We have been set free by the gospel of Jesus. Our submission to false teaching and false teachers who try to "enhance" our faith with a "Jesus plus" teaching will not lead us to a true faith, or a faithful life.

KNOW: Laws and legalism will not save you. Those who tell you how it has saved them will not help you. We must draw wisdom and perseverance from Christ. Only he has the substance to sustain you through life and death.

DO: Turn away from shadows. Find substance in Jesus.
