## Children, Youth & Families in Church

**Changing tables** are located in the handicap stalls of both bathrooms in the undercroft, nursery and Bishops Hall foyer.

**Nursery Care** - Our High School Nursery Ministry team welcomes our littlest church members with joy and experienced care! The nursery is open from 10:00am to 12:00pm for children 3 years and under, including infants. Children in PK3-5th are encouraged to join us for Godly Play.

**Spirit Bags** for children are located at the entrance to worship. Please return materials as you exit.

**The Pray Ground at the 10:30am worship service** is a designated area where children can experience worship while being physically comfortable. Spirit bags are available to help children stay engaged. Parents are responsible for the behavior and safety of their children.

**Godly Play** - We invite children PK3-5th grade to enter into a deeper and more playful relationship with God. The children meet during the "Sunday school hour" from 10:30am to 11:15am. Classes are organized by grade. After class, the children are led by their respective Godly Play mentors to join their families for communion. Sometimes we're a little late.

### About Godly Play (not your typical sunday school!)

The Godly Play® method is a curriculum of spiritual practice exploring the mystery of God's presence in our lives and builds upon a Montessori foundation that has been extensively researched and practiced for over 40 years. At its core, Godly Play emphasizes the importance of process, openness, discovery, community, and relationships and models the worship life, stories, symbols, and rituals of our Christian faith. Consistency is key.
