[The Living Well Community Centre](#) in Yuen Long, run by Union Church missionary Andrew Ahmed, celebrated its opening with a special Vision Sharing and Dedication Ceremony on September 12, 2025. Union Church members were there to witness this inspiring evening of grace. This Centre is the embodiment of Andrew’s calling to serve the Muslim and Hindu communities in Hong Kong. The new location now serves as a home for fellowship and Bible study groups of Hindi and Urdu-speaking individuals. Andrew’s ministry also provides social services and support—including prison and hospital visits—to refugees and asylum seekers.



Kindness Walk is Union Church's monthly community outreach to share Christ's love with our often-overlooked neighbors in the Wan Chai district. The team visits the street cleaning workers at local garbage collection centers and also the homeless in the area. We exchange greetings with them and also bring practical gifts, including masks, fresh fruits, and snacks, as a tangible expression of love and respect for those working hard or struggling to get by in our community. A New Year of Faith and Fun at Inner City Ministries!

A new school year has begun, and with it, the Saturday afternoon Kid's Club at Inner City Ministries has resumed! Every second Saturday afternoon of the month, Union Church volunteers run the vibrant Kids' Club program which serves the Nepalese children in the Jordan neighborhood. Over 50 kids, happily divided into three age groups, engage in fun activities including games, songs, arts and crafts and, most importantly of all, Bible lessons. Significantly, many of these children come from a Hindu background and are the first in their families to learn about Jesus. May God powerfully use the seeds of faith planted in this ministry to reach and bless the children's families as well. Our next service at ICM will be on **Oct 11**. Please join us!



St. Barnabas Home and Society English Reading Program Kick-off

On September 27, we successfully kicked off the Children English Reading Program 2025-2026 at St. Barnabas Society and Home (SBSH)! Praise the Lord that 19 dedicated volunteers served, seven of them for the very first time. Our vibrant multi-generational team represented various Union Church ministries, including kids, youth, young adults, choir, and small groups. This year, we have expanded the program to include Bible stories, allowing us to share the message of Jesus with the children. We also host a concurrent program for parents, praying that this ministry expands its impact and creates opportunities to share the Gospel with their families. We serve at St. Barnabas on the fourth Saturday morning of each month. The next service will be on **Oct 25**.
