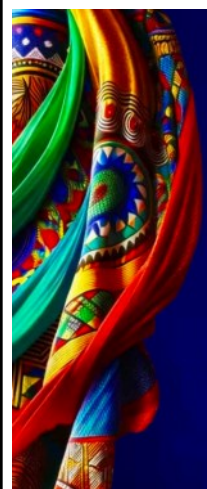

Joy doesn't rise and fall with our emotions. It is not something we force, manufacture, or pretend to have. True joy is rooted in who God is, not in how we feel. A Women's Discipleship Study

Shenika Lewis, Instructor

For many women, sexuality has been shaped by a mixture of silence, expectations, personal experiences, and unspoken assumptions, often more than by Scripture itself. Some learned early what was "allowed" or "forbidden," but were never invited to understand God's heart, His design, or His redemptive purpose. Others carry questions, tension, or quiet struggles they've never known how to bring into the light.

This 11-week discipleship study is open to **both single and married women** and is designed to be a thoughtful, grace-filled space for spiritual formation. Together, we will examine long-held beliefs and allow God's Word to speak clearly and compassionately into an area that deeply shapes identity, relationships, and faith. This is not a space for pressure, comparison, or quick answers. It is a space for truth, reflection, healing, and growth.

Whether you are single, dating, engaged, or married, and no matter what your story includes, you are welcome here. Come ready to listen, learn, and be shaped as we explore God's design for sexuality with honesty, wisdom, and grace.

Acts and Selected Pauline Epistles

Dr. Edsel Dureus, Instructor

No Fee

This course explores the book of Acts and selected letters of Paul, focusing on their biblical theology, literary genres, and practical application. Students will study key events in the birth and growth of the early church and gain an understanding of each book's historical background, structure, purpose, and message. Emphasis is placed on learning how to read and interpret different biblical genres and seeing

how these writings fit within the broader story of the New Testament. 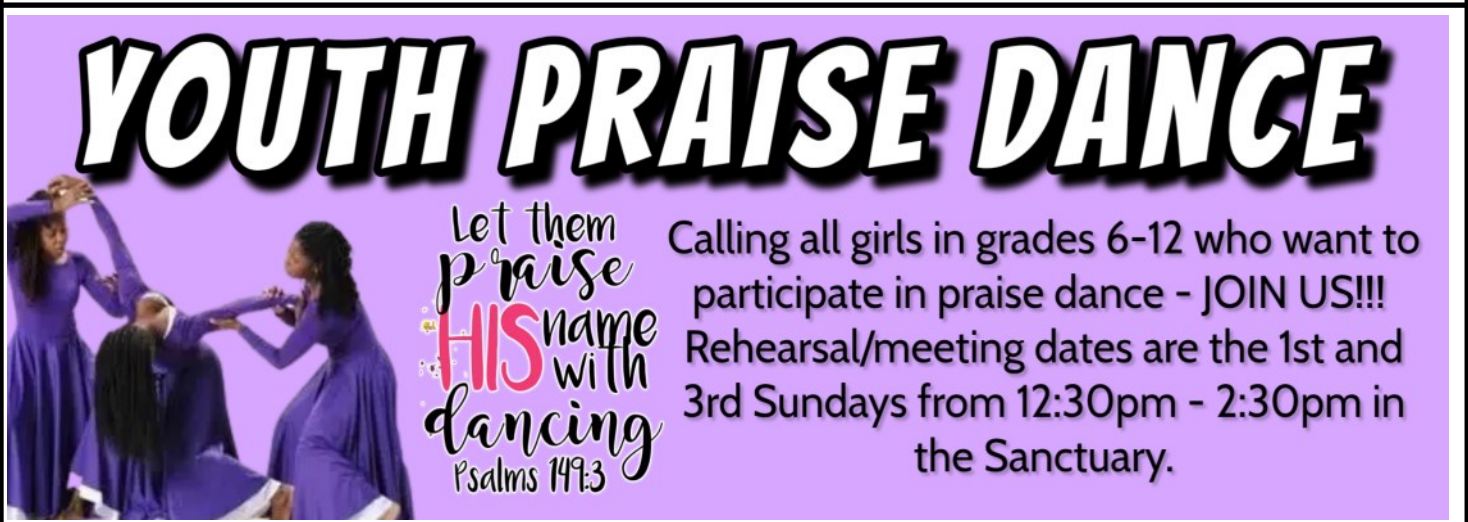

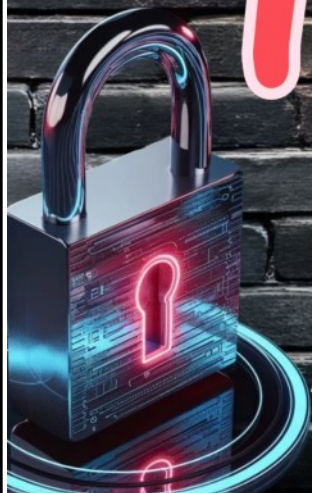

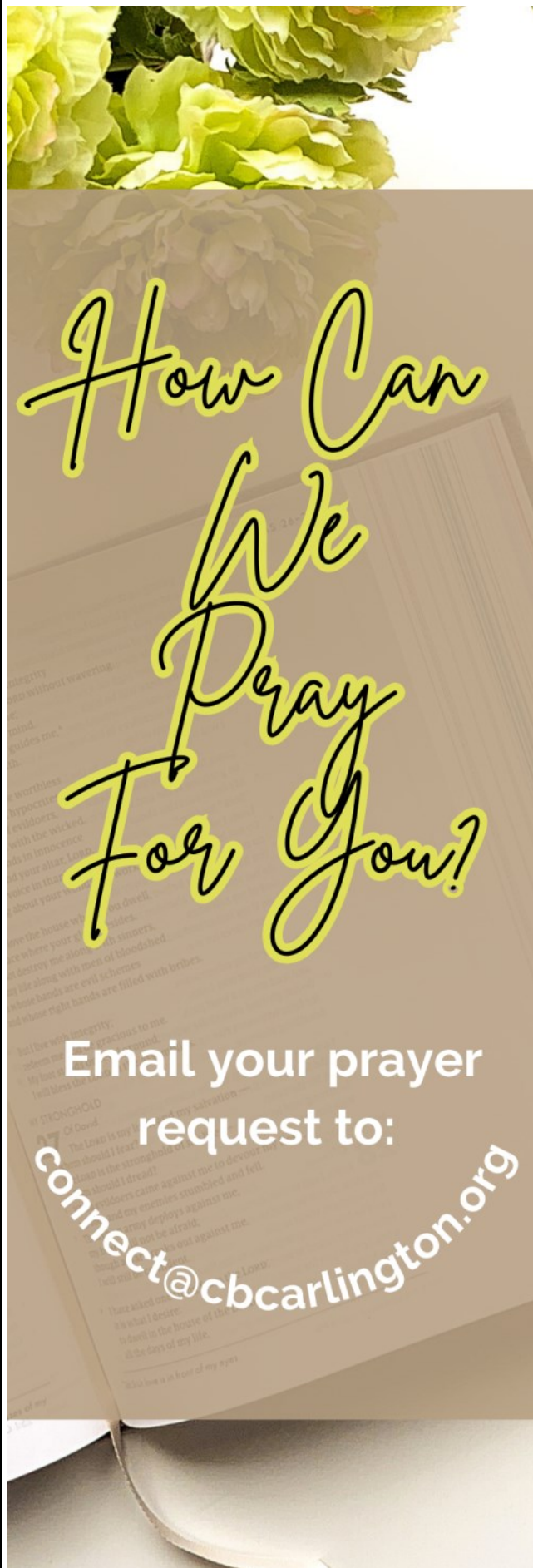
