

BREAST & PROSTATE CANCER

October is Breast and Prostate Cancer Awareness Month at Cornerstone Church! The Wellness Ministry of Cornerstone Church invites you to join us throughout the month of October as we celebrate cancer survivors and raise awareness of both breast and prostate cancer.

On Sunday, October 26th, we encourage everyone to wear pink (in support of breast cancer awareness) and light blue (in support of prostate cancer awareness) as we honor our survivors during service.

Stop by the tables in the foyer for prevention and awareness materials, along with pins and bracelets to show your support—available while supplies last!

Breast Cancer Facts

- Breast cancer is the most common cancer diagnosed among women in the U.S., representing about 32% of all newly diagnosed cancers in women each year.
- One percent of those diagnosed are men.
- African American women are more likely to die from breast cancer than women of any other racial or ethnic group.
- Although African American women have a 5% lower incidence of breast cancer than white women, they face a 38% higher mortality rate.
- Early detection saves lives! Annual mammogram screenings, a healthy lifestyle, and understanding your risk factors are essential.

Prostate Cancer Facts

- Prostate cancer is the most common cancer among men in the U.S., accounting for 30% of male cancers in 2025.
- One in eight men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer during their lifetime.
- African American men are 1.7 times more likely to be diagnosed and 2.1 times more likely to die from prostate cancer than white men.
- Early detection saves lives! Regular PSA blood tests, a healthy lifestyle, and knowing your risks are vital.

Let's come together as a church family to support our survivors, spread awareness, and promote early detection—because together, we can make a difference!



Make Jesus Personal To Your Life - Studying The "I AM" Statements of Christ Veronica Griffith, Instructor Book Fee \$8

Our greatest witness is our own story of how Christ has impacted our lives. Every Christian has a story to tell but many don't know how to tell it or have spent little time thinking about how to verbalize what Christ has done in their life. We often say, "Christ has changed my life" and if we ask Christians, the question, "have you experienced the power of the Holy Spirit in your life?", most will reply with a confident "yes". But what happens when we go a step further and ask how or when? So often, we stumble over providing the details. 


