Youth Retreat 2024 Rules & Acknowledgment Form

1. Everyone is expected to strive to imitate the character of Jesus Christ throughout each moment of our time together.
2. **Students must be dropped off by a parent or guardian.**
3. **Absolutely no weapons, tobacco, alcohol or vaping products. There will be zero tolerance. Student's bags will be searched upon arrival. If contraband is found the student will not be allowed to attend camp and the registration fee will not be refunded.**
4. Everyone attending at camp must be registered.
5. If a student has medication of any kind, it must be disclosed during parent drop off.
6. **In order to promote Biblical purity and modesty Cornerstone Church has the following clothing regulations.**
 - a. Shorts and skirts must come between the fingertips (when the arm is at rest) to the top of the knee.
 - b. No open sided shirts, bare midriffs, or see-through tops.
 - c. No clothing with offensive messages as determined by leadership.
 - d. No excessive cleavage or underwear should be seen at any time.
7. Students must keep cabin area tidy at all times.
8. No student is allowed in the kitchen area at any time.
9. No student may leave the premises with anyone other than a parent or guardian without informing leadership.
10. Students are solely responsible for keeping up with and maintaining any items that they choose to bring to the camp. Cornerstone Church is not liable for any items lost, stolen or damaged.
11. All students are to attend scheduled events unless excused by leadership.
12. Girl campers are not allowed in the boy's sleeping area, and boy campers are not allowed in the girls' sleeping area.
13. Students are expected to abide by all camp rules. If the student does not conduct themselves in a proper Christian manner, the leadership has the right to send the student home. If the students have any items with them that are inconsistent with the rules, they should be turned in to leadership. Parents are required to pick up the student immediately upon request by leadership.

We're excited to be traveling to Camp Copass in Denton, Texas for our 2024 Youth Retreat.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

The group will be traveling by chartered bus to and from the retreat.

All youth need to be at the church no later than 2:00pm, Friday, July 26, 2024. The bus will leave at 3pm headed to Denton, TX. Our travel time will be 1 – 1.5 hours.

We will have dinner at Camp Copass at 7:00pm.

We will depart from Denton, TX Sunday, July 28, 2024 at 11:00am. We should arrive at Cornerstone Church between 12:00 – 12:15pm. Please meet us at the church by 12:00pm to pick up your student.

AVAILABLE ACTIVITIES & EXTRA EXPENSES

CAMP COPASS CAMP STORE

RETREAT DISCOUNTS

Many of you have multiple students in the program and we understand that the cost can add up quickly for all of the students to go. We are offering the following discount for multiple students from one family:

\$120 for the first student / \$100 for the second student/ \$80 for the third student/ \$60 for the fourth student. A \$50 deposit is required for your child at registration. The deposit is non-refundable after July 7, 2024.

A payment plan can be set up to pay off the retreat balance by September 1, 2024. Please select payment plan on your registration form.

If you need financial assistance, please contact the church office. We want every student to attend the retreat and don't want the finances to be a hinderance for the fun weekend away.
