Read together Genesis 12: 1-9. Choose from below questions for discussion

Discussion Questions

1. When God called Abram to leave everything familiar, he didn’t know exactly where he was going. How does uncertainty make faith both challenging and necessary in our own lives?
2. Abram responded to God’s call by building altars as he traveled. What “altars” (practices, reminders, or markers) help you remember God’s faithfulness as you take steps of faith?
3. God promised Abram that he would bless him and make him a blessing. In what ways can stepping out in faith both bless us and others?
4. Abram’s call required leaving behind comfort and security. What are some “comfort zones” God might be inviting us to release so we can step more fully into His plan?
5. Abram didn’t see the full picture, but he trusted God’s word. How do we learn to trust God’s promises even when our present circumstances don’t yet reflect them?
6. Does it change your perspective if you think of God down here working instead of there watching?
7. What’s the difference between asking God to bless what you are doing and you blessing what God is doing?
