

Road Trip: On the Go with God! Week 1
Off the Edge of Your Map
Genesis 12:1-3; Hebrews 11:8, 2 Timothy 2:1-2
Week of July 6, 2025
Group Discussion Guide

Read together Genesis 12:1-3; Hebrews 11:8

- **Are you a map follower or “let’s wing it” type of person? How does it make you feel when you find yourself off the map – off the path you’ve been following?**

In his Sermon Message, Pastor Doug said, “We don’t know the future, but we serve the one who holds the future.

- **How does knowing the one who holds the future make you feel? Does it make it easier to go off map?**
- **Think about a time when you did (willingly or not) go off map – a time of transition like college, job, marriage, crisis, scary diagnosis, becoming parents – did anyone come alongside you to make it easier?**
- **Who could you come alongside and help make their uncharted journey a little easier? How could you do that?**
 - To get you started thinking, here are a few ways you could do that at Woodside: mentor a high school student getting ready for college, serve on the Reach team and provide meals or visits to someone going through a crisis, provide babysitting for a young parents growth group so they can deepen their faith...

Read together Timothy 2:1-2

- Woodside’s Mission says we help others: Love God, Grow in Grace and Share with Others. **What does it mean to you to be a disciple that makes disciples? If you’re not actively making disciples, how can you/your group focus on this?**

Pastor Doug spoke about three mission fields:

- Big/Macro Church (current church at Edgewood and Heacock Roads)
- Micro Churches – small (4 -12 people) groups connected to the big church meeting throughout the community reaching people who do not want to come into a “traditional” church setting
- Digital – connected to the big church; reaching people throughout the world via online media.
- **Which field do you feel called to?**

To accomplish the mission of growing our outreach and making disciples who make disciples, Woodside will need many new leaders. Pray about where God is calling you so you are ready to answer His call.
