Read together Hebrews 1: Look for the following key themes:

- Jesus as the radiance of God's glory
- Superiority of the Son over angels
- Jesus as Creator and Sustainer
- His eternal kingship and divine nature

Study Questions:

1. What does Hebrews 1:1-2 tell us about the way God speaks to us now compared to the past?

Why is Jesus being God's final word a source of hope for believers?

2. Verse 3 describes Jesus as "the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of His being."

What does this mean, and how does it affect your view of who Jesus is?

3. According to Hebrews 1:3, what has Jesus done for us, and why is it significant for our hope?

(Hint: Think about purification for sins and sitting at the right hand of God.)

- 4. Why is Jesus' position "at the right hand of the Majesty on high" important in terms of our confidence and hope?
- 5. How does Hebrews 1 compare Jesus to angels (vv. 4–14)?

 Why is it encouraging to know that Jesus is far superior to any spiritual being?
- 6. Hebrews 1:8 refers to Jesus' throne being eternal. How does this truth impact your understanding of His role as King?

How does His eternal rule bring stability and hope?

- 7. **Verse 10 refers to Jesus as the one who laid the foundations of the earth.**What hope does knowing Jesus as Creator give you in the face of life's uncertainties?
- 8. What does the contrast between creation "wearing out" and Jesus "remaining the same" (vv. 11–12) say about His reliability?
- 9. How can the truths in Hebrews 1 shape the way you approach challenges, doubt, or fear?

What practical hope does this chapter give you for daily life?

10. Reflect on one attribute of Jesus from Hebrews 1 that stands out to you. How can you lean on this aspect of Jesus more in your walk of faith?
