Unlimited Access

The Letter to the Hebrews is one of the most mysterious and fascinating books in the New Testament. We don't know who wrote it or who received it. It's not really even a letter. It seems more like a sermon – a message to people who are worn out, weary and wary about the future. Some are even thinking of giving up on Jesus.

To them, and to us, Hebrews declares we have a solid Hope and a certain Future in Jesus. It pulls back the curtain and offers us Unlimited Access into the Throne Room of God.

Between Easter and Pentecost, read a small portion of Hebrews each day. Go over it a few times. Check the notes in your Study Bible. Discover what the words meant to the first listeners and how they apply to you today. Let this be your daily backstage pass to meet, not just with a Superstar, but the God who made all the stars!
